

On November 24, at 7:32 p.m. light a candle of remembrance and reflect in a moment of silence to honour the memory of the victims of the Holodomor as an international commemoration.

Ukrainian Catholics refer to the pre-Christmas fast period as Pylypivka or St. Philip's Fast, as it always begins on the day after the feast of St. Philip the Apostle, November 15. It ends on December 24th.

This fast once had very strict rules. Today, the Church encourages us to abstain from meat on Wednesdays and Fridays. We are also required to practice the spirit of sacrifice, penance, especially charity.

To prepare to celebrate the joy of Christmas, we fast, we pray more and we increase our acts of love and compassion. Let us approach this time of preparation in the hope that it allows us to experience a new awareness of His presence.

Read and Reflect during this Christmas fast. Set time aside each day to spend in prayer and reading connected with Christmas and its meaning. This can include readings from the Old Testament, especially from the prophets, who foretold the coming of the Messiah.
