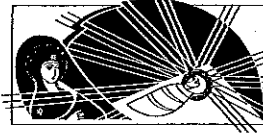

Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

It's the beginning of a **New Year** and I should be writing to you about **Resolutions**, etc, but I think that I will share with you the story about **"THE STRANGER"** instead...



A father of a family met a stranger who recently came into town and was immediately fascinated with him. And soon the father invited him to come and live with his family. The stranger was quickly accepted by the entire family and no one in the house ever even questioned him

The **mother** of the family taught the children **solid Christian values**, the **father** taught the children to be obedient. The **"stranger"** however, would keep the children absolutely spellbound for hours with adventures, mysteries and comedies. If anyone in the house wanted to know anything about politics, history or science, the stranger always had the answers for he was very intelligent and wise! The stranger never stopped talking... and the parents seemingly encouraged this.

The **father** would rule his household with **certain moral convictions**, but the **"stranger"** never felt obligated to honor them. Profanity, for example, was not allowed in that home – not from the children, or the friends or any visitors, but the **"stranger"** could speak as he wanted to and this often made both parents quite uncomfortable.

The **stranger** was often blatant, sometimes suggestive and generally embarrassing. Consequently, he had a strong influence on the views of the entire household. Time after time, he publicly opposed the values of the parents and yet he was seldom rebuked and never asked to leave.

More than 50 years passed since the stranger moved in with this family. He blended right in and is not nearly as fascinating as he had been at first. And if you were to walk into this house today, you would find him sitting over in his corner, always waiting for someone to listen to him talk.

What is this **stranger's** name? They just call him **MR. TV...** but now he has a **wife...** and her name is **Mrs. Computer!**

It's a simple story but I am reasonably sure that most of us recognize this stranger for he now lives in most of our homes as well and we often give him far more attention than we should. Yes, he is fascinating, he is intriguing and he is funny. But should he be sitting at the head of our tables? Do we have to give him the **right to set the standards of our lives?**

As we commence our **2013**, let us focus, if but for a moment, on the **strangers in our homes**. And let us remember that it is **our choice** where they will sit and how much attention we will give them.

May we have the strength to stand up to the **"strangers"** in our home and may we restore the family atmosphere and the peace that truly needs to belong there always!

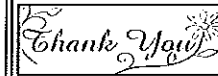

Христос Раждається!

Я повинен писати вам листа на тему Нового Року але я думаю, що я краще поділюся з вами розповіддю про «Незнайомця».

Одного разу до одного міста приїхав незнайомець і батько одної родини дуже собі його сподобав. Скоро він запросив незнайомця до себе до хати на постійне перебування і вони його зразу прийняли, як члена родини. Незнайомець знайшов собі між ними місце і ніхто не ставив йому жодних питань.

Мама в цій родині навчала дітей правильних життєвих засад, батько вчив дітей слухняності, а незнайомець... годинами чарував дітей розповідями, пригодами, таємницями та комедіями. Коли хтось в хаті мав питання на тему політики, історії чи природничих наук, незнайомець завжди вмів на всі питання відповісти бо ж він був дуже розумним. Цей незнайомець ніколи не переставав говорити... і батьки це заохочували.


Батько вимагавав від членів своєї родини здорових моральних засад а незнайомець уважав, що ці правила до нього не відносяться. Наприклад, батьки у своєму домі не дозволяли ні дітям, ні друзям ні гостям нецензурної мови, але незнайомець міг говорити, як хотів і часто батькам у власному домі ставало в його присутності невідносно.

Незнайомець часто був крикливим, нераз непристойним і, як правило, всіх бентежив. В результаті, він мав великий вплив на світогляд всіх мешканців дому і раз по раз протиставився цінностям батьків, але батьки ніколи йому не опонували.

Минуло понад 50 років від коли незнайомець став жити з цією родиною і він вже давно не є таким чарівним, як спершу. І, як би ви сьогодні увійшли до них до хати, ви побачили б його в куті, там де завжди, чекаючи на кого небудь, хто готовий його вислухати.

Як його звати? Вони просто на нього кажуть **Телебачення**... але він одружився... і його жінку звати **Компютер!**

Це проста розповідь але я думаю, що всі ми пізнаємо цього незнайомця, бо він тепер вже оселився у кожному домі і, як багато людей, ми приділяємо йому забагато уваги. Так, він цікавий, він інтригує і він веселий але, чи повинні ми саджати його на чолі свого стола? Чи треба йому дозволяти право на встановлення життєвих засад?

У підготовці до Нового Року, хоч на хвилинку, звернім увагу на **незнайомців** у своєму домі. І не забуваймо, що це наше рішення, де ми їх посадимо і скільки ми їм дамо уваги. Дай Боже, щоб ми мали силу зі сміливістю відноситися до незнайомців у наших домах, щоб ми могли повернути до своєї хати родинне тепло та спокій...
