

Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be Forever! Dear Parishioners and Guests,

When authorities want to discourage drivers from speeding here in Winnipeg, they place a narrow piece of asphalt across the road. It is called a "speed bump", and is meant to make us slow down. Allow these thoughts to be your church's speed bump. On Feb. 11 Th, we spiritually commenced the holy season of Great Lent. Let's slow down and do some reflecting – especially on forgiveness...

We often mistakenly think that "forgiveness" is something we do for someone else; yet in reality, it is a gift that we give to ourselves. Forgiving someone means being willing to overlook the wrong and the pain that has been committed against you, and then wisely moving on with your life. Indubitably, part of you will strongly resist, saying: "What? Forgive them? Did you see what they did to me? I will never forgive!"

But <u>you must</u> forgive! "*Not forgiving*" keeps you in an eternal struggle. Whereas, the willingness to forgive can bring a <u>sense of peace and well being</u>. It effectively lifts anxiety and liberates you from depression. It enhances your low self-esteem and gives you much needed hope.

Whether you committed a sin or someone else committed it against you is not so important. If you are obsessing about it, YOU are the one who must act to change! Who cares who started it! What is more urgent who will end it. This is not to say that there is no such thing as right or wrong. Certainly, there are such things as aggression, dishonesty and faithlessness. But if you are not willing to move on from the wrong done to you, this could be more painful for you than the original "hurt".

Please do not foster a grudge for long periods of time. And for God's sake and yours, do not be angry for weeks or months. Perhaps you we're the *wounded innocent*. The fault may be completely theirs. Yet you are the one who is a prisoner within.

We are not only called to forgive huge transgessions. There are 100's of things in our daily lives that also need our forgiveness. <u>Forgive</u> those who cut you off in traffic. <u>Forgive</u> the person who stole your parking space. <u>Forgive</u> the one who took that last piece of cake that you had been waiting for. <u>Forgive</u> those who ignore you and <u>forgive</u> those who gossip about you. <u>Forgive</u> the person who was late and made you wait all afternoon. <u>Forgive</u> the person who laughed at you. And especially, <u>forgive</u> yourself for the stupid and harmful things that you did and do to yourself!

Yes, forgive and forgive... and really listen to the words of your daily prayer: "Father, forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." It is so true, it is not always easy to forgive by one's own strength- but then we are not alone! We have an ever-loving God to Whom we can turn for help. Remember how He looked upon His tormentors from the cross and forgave them. God does give us the grace to do the same! We must sincerely pray for this great blessing!





Veneration of the Cross

"To Your Cross, O Master, we bow in veneration, And we glorify Your Holy Resurrection."

We are now at the halfway point of Lent.

This is a good time to review our progress in our Lenten journey.



How are we doing in our preparation for Easter? To assure us of a proper focus, the Church, on this Sunday of the Veneration of the Holy Cross, reminds us of what preceded the glorious resurrection. Reflection on Christ's Passion and Crucifixion is a significant part of our Lenten journey.

Today we place an adorned cross on the sacramental altar to show us how much God loved us. The Cross is the most honored and cherished of Christian symbols. As we gaze upon the Cross, we are reminded of how costly it was for Jesus to win our salvation. It cost Jesus, the Son of God, his life. No wonder St. Paul exclaimed: "You are not your own; you are bought with a price." And what a price it was!...the painful suffering and death of Christ on the Cross. As we venerate the Cross at the conclusion of the Divine Liturgy today, let us reverently bow down before it and kiss it saying. "Jesus, thank you. Help me to bear my cross."

Each of us in our daily lives are often challenged by some 'cross' or another - be it a personal weakness, a health issue, a loss in the family, an addiction, unemployment, a stressful relationship, dealing with a prodigal, etc. As we entrust our cross(es) to the Lord, our true grit and Christian identity are obvious. And, lo and behold, just as Christ suffered, died, and rose, so we too, after carrying our cross and uniting ours with that of Jesus, experience our victories, mini-resurrections, and are forever grateful.

As difficult as it was for Jesus to bear all that agony for us and not to forsake us. He says to all of those around the Cross and to us personally: "Father forgive them; they do not know what they are doing." It is our sins that have put Jesus on the Cross. We should know better, being aware of what it cost Jesus the Son of God. Thank goodness for His patience with us. "Carpe diem." "Let us cease the day."
