Are we holding on to the euphoria of resurrection that it is impacting the way we live - everyday?

A message from the Holy Father...

Pope Francis had a Mass Tuesday, April 2 with the staff from the Vatican medical services and office staff of the Vatican City Government: he concluded his homily by saying the following....

The Holy Father then outlined the correct behavior for a Christian. First, "do not judge anyone" because "the only Judge is the Lord." Then "keep quiet" and if you have something to say, say it to the interested parties, to those "who can remedy the situation," but "not to the entire neighborhood."

"If, by the grace of the Holy Spirit – concluded Pope Francis - we succeed in never gossiping, it will be a great step forward" and "will do us all good".

In the footsteps of St. Francis of Assisi, Pope Francis calls attention to Lady Poverty and to the great need for the whole Church to remember the poor, the outcast and the forgotten.

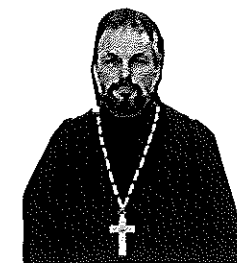
