What do I look for in a friend and what will my friend do for me?... Why should I have to work so hard?... Will this bring me fame and money? I deserve for it to be MINE!... Why should I care?... Why should I have to listen to him?... I want it NOW!...

Pastor's Desk

How very contrary all of this is to the teachings of Christ, for He always taught us to put others before ourselves and he lived His life accordingly. Christ not only taught against selfishness, he gave a perfect antidote for it. That antidote is Love. *"A new commandment I give unto you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men know that you are my disciples if you have love one to another."* (John 13:34-35).

Recently I read an article by Richard Baxter where he discusses how much better our world would be without egoism. He asks his readers to think of what selfishness does to us. He asks that we stop to think of what egoism does to our body: how many health problems are the direct result of gluttony and laziness. Let's also think of what egoism does to our mind: It keeps us from learning new things because we are too proud to admit we were wrong. Let us think of what it does to our spiritual life. It drives us to do many bad things and keeps us from changing for the better because we think we are better than others. Let us think of what egoism does to marriages! I wonder how many arguments husbands and wives have because they are first thinking of themselves. Let us think of what egoism does to children. Egoistic parents neglect their children because they have things that they themselves would prefer to do or they make too many demands on their children because they want to impose their own will on them.

Imagine how much happier our world would be if we were all to think first of *someone else rather than of ourselves*. There would then be no pride, no covetousness, no tyranny or oppressing of the poor, no malice or cruelty or persecution. There would be no divisions, no scandals, no fraud or treacheries, no abuse of others, no lying or deceit, no neglect of our duty to others; in a word there would be no injustice in the world.

Let us give this matter much thought. How often we complain about the problems of the world and yet the solution lies within each of us. If each of us would think about how much we can GIVE instead of how much we can GET...if each of us would stop counting how much someone else has but would rather think of how we could share the many things that we each have... if we would only address the needs of others rather than our own... if we would think of how we could bring pleasure to others before we go looking for pleasure of our own... I promise you that the world would be a far better place in which to live...

Це все сильно заперечує навчання Христа, бо Ісус Христос завжди вчив, щоб ми клали інших перед себе і він служив сильним прикладом цієї науки. Воно нас наштотвує до поганих вчинків та здержує нас від зміни до кращого, бо ми уважаємо себе кращими за інших. Подумаймо, як егоїзм торкається подружжя! Цікаво мені скільки є непорозумінь, коли обоє в подружжі перше думають про себе. Подумаймо, як егоїзм впливає на дітей. Коли батьки є егоїстами і перше думають за себе, вони занедбують дітей, а також кривдять цих дітей, коли накидають на них свою волю і забагато від них вимагають.

Уявіть собі, на як багато кращим був би наш світ, якби ми всі перше думали за інших замість за себе. Не було би тоді в світі зарозумілості, задрості, тиранії чи пригноблення бідних. Не було би злочинних намірів, жорстокості та переслідування. Не було би незгоди, скандалів, шахрайства, зрад, зловживання, брехні, обману чи зневаги – одним словом, у світі не було би несправедливості.

Замислімся над цим. Ми часто нарікаємо на світові проблеми, але вирішення цих проблем лежить у наших власних руках. Якби кожний із нас подумав, скільки можна б ДАТИ, замість скільки ми можемо самі скористати... якби кожний із нас перестав рахувати чуже майно, але краще взяв до уваги, як найкраще поділитися тим, що ми маємо... якщо би ми звертали увагу на чужі потреби замість на свої... якби ми обдумали, як покращити життя іншим, а щойно тоді подумали про себе... я запевняю вас, що щойно тоді матимемо кращий світ, кращий світ...
