If your mother is no longer with you, pray for her.








If you are fortunate enough to have her still with you, lift her up in prayer and tell her that you love her.

І ось, коли списав цілий листок, то показав мамі, а вона вголос почала читати: «Рахунок Миколи своїй мамі: Три рази приніс молоко: 0,5 дол., 2 рази прибрав кухню – 1,5 дол., три рази повитирав посуд – 1 долар, 5 разів почистив одяг – 1,5 долари, 4 рази накривав стіл – 2 доларів. Все разом 6,5 доларів.

Мати засміялася, коли прочитала цей дивний рахунок. Тоді сама взяла олівець. «І я напишу тобі свій рахунок», сказала вона. «Твій рахунок? – здивовано запитав Давид. - Ти що, також щось для мене зробила?». «Ну так, трошки», кивнула мама і почала писати: «Рахунок мамі синові Миколі: 8 років для нього варила їсти – 0,0 доларів; 8 років для нього прала – 0,0 дол., 25 штанів і курток для нього зашила і залатала – 0,0 дол., 100 ночей просиділа біля нього, коли він був хворий – 0,0 дол. Все разом – 0. дол. Хлопчисько уважно і децю роззублено читав рахунок мамі.

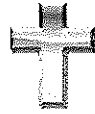
