Dear Beloved of St. Joseph's,

When I was walking downtown one time, I was witness to an interesting scene. A young woman with two small children was standing at the corner of a street and hailing a taxi and several of them went by and none of them stopped to pick her up. A tall man came up behind her and, seeing a cab approach, waved his hand, yelled loudly and the driver stopped. The woman became upset that this man "stole" her taxi and scolded him. And he looked at her very patiently and said: "I don't need a cab! I walk to work... I did this for you!"

Such a simple thing and yet isn't this, what our life consists of... or rather SHOULD consist of? We rarely deal in large acts. Most of the things that we do are small, seemingly inconsequential things, but these small things touch someone often and much. There are hundreds of opportunities every day when we could be "hailing a cab" for someone be it in our families, among our friends, among our co-workers or even with perfect strangers, but do we? Or do we just hurry along, absorbed in our own troubles... or simply mind our own business? Or, perhaps we have high expectations of gratitude and this motivates our actions. Are we willing to bring others warmth even if there is no applause after what we do? Not everyone will be grateful or even know how to say "Thank you!" - so we should do acts of kindness because we believe in them and not because we expect something in return.

Kindness has touched the lives of people from time immemorial. Confucius wrote "Forget injuries, never forget kindness." Aesop wrote, "No act of kindness, no matter how small, is ever wasted." Philosopher Arthur Schopenhauer wrote, "Compassion is the basis of all morality." The Dalai Lama of Tibet writes, "If you want others to be happy, practice compassion. If you want to be happy, practice compassion!" And the quote that I particularly like to remember is from Quaker Etienne Grellet who wrote "I expect to pass through this world just once; any good thing therefore that I can do, or any kindness that I can show to any fellow creature, let me do it now; let me not defer or neglect it, for I shall not pass this way again."

Yes, very often life just gives us one chance to do good toward someone, particularly, if they are strangers. Let us not pass up any opportunity! In fact, let us never let a day go by without if but one act of kindness!


There is a simple rule that we should abide by... whenever we look at someone, we should try seeing Jesus Christ in them. We should look for Jesus, not only in the nice people that we know, but we should look for Jesus in every one, for if we do, I assure you that we will treat people differently. I cannot imagine that we would turn our head away from Jesus... or ignore Him if we saw that He needed something.


Let us look for Jesus in people and then not walk, but run to give them warmth and understanding.....



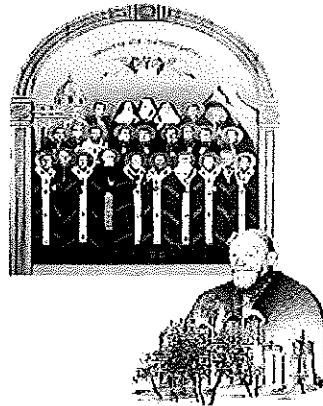

Слава Ісусу Христу!

Коли я одного разу був в місті, я бачив цікаву сцену. Молода жінка стояла з двома дітьми на розі вулиці і старалася затримати таксі і хоч декілька таксі проїхали попри неї, жодна на її прохання не зупинилася. Тим часом, біля неї став високий чоловік і, побачивши, що їде таксі, помахав рукою та голосно крикнув і водій таксі зупинився. Жінка побачила, що чоловік “вкрав” її таксі і це її вивело з рівноваги. А він спокійно на неї подивився і сказав: “Мені не потрібно таксі! Я іду до праці пішки... я зупинив для Тебе!”

Ніби проста річ, але як часто наше життя з подібного складається... або скоріше **ПОВИННО** складатися. Ми рідко коли в житті зустрічаємося з великими ділами. Більшість подій у нашому житті малі і на перший вигляд незначні, але ми, завдяки малим справам, когось часто та багато торкаємося. Ми щодня маємо сотки нагод “*викликати комусь таксі*” в родині, між друзями, посеред співпрацівників чи просто з чужими людьми, але чи ми це робимо? А може ми просто пробігаємо через життя, задумані у власних клопотах і турбуємося лиш власним ділом. А може ми маємо великі сподівання на велику вдячність. Чи ми готові приносити іншим тепло, навіть якщо після цього ніхто не буде вітати нас бурними оплесками? Не кожна людина завжди вдячна а навіть якщо вдячна, не все вміє сказати “Дякую!” Отже, ми повинні виконувати добрі діла тому, що ми віримо в те, що робимо, а не тому, що ми сподіваємося якоїсь винагороди.

Доброчинність торкається людей від незапам’ятних часів. Конфуцій писав, “*Забувайте всі образи, але ніколи на забудьте доброчинності.*” Езоп писав, “*Жодна доброчинність, яка би вона була незначна, не є даремна.*” Філософ Артур Шопенгауер писав, “*Співчуття – це підстава всієї моральності.*” Далай Лама з Тибету пише, “*Якщо ти хочеш щоб інші були щасливими, будь співчутливим. Якщо хочеш сам бути щасливим, будь співчутливим.*” А цитата, яку я особливо стараюся пам’ятати - це слова квакера Етієн Ґреллет, який писав “*Я сподіваюся пройти цим світом лиш раз; отож будь яке добро, яке я можу принести або добре діло, яке я можу вчинити супроти іншої людини, треба робити зараз; не смію баритися з цим, чи занедбати це, бо ж більше ніколи сюди не прийду!*”

Так, дуже часто життя дарує нам лише одну нагоду чинити комусь добро, особливо комусь незнайомому. Не прогавмо жодної нагоди! До речі, *нехай у нас не буде дня хоч без одного доброго діла.*

Є дуже проста засада, якої ми повинні притримуватися - коли дивимося на когось, стараймося бачити у ньому Ісуса Христа. Шукаймо Ісуса у людях і не лише у приємних, знайомих нам, але у кожному і я запевняю вас, що ми з вами будемо зовсім інакше до людей ставитися. Тяжко повірити, щоб хтось із нас відвертав голову від Ісуса, або щоб зневажав Його потреби. Шукаймо Ісуса у людях і не йдім, але біжім до них з теплом та виrozumінням...

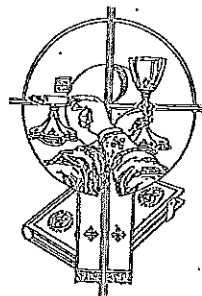
