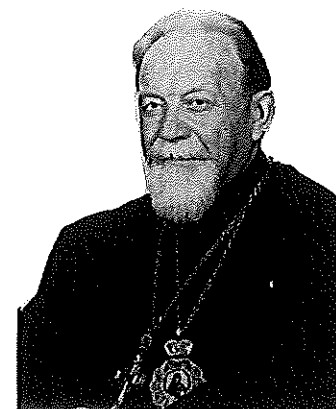

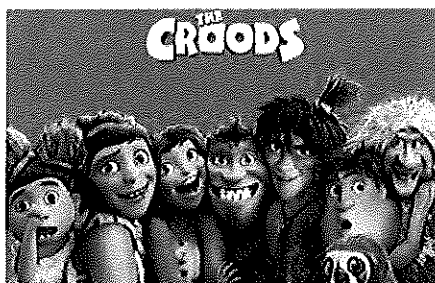

July 10 - July 30, 2014

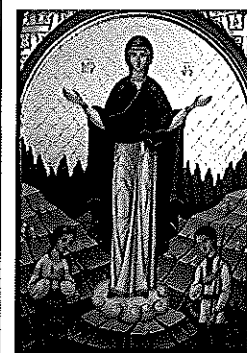
