Dear Beloved Parishioners & Guests,

May I ask you a question? Are you able to go for 24 hours without saying an unkind word to anyone or about someone? If you cannot, then I suspect that you have a serious problem. For if I were to ask you if you can go for 24 hours without alcohol and you were to answer that you cannot, then whether you admit it or not you have a drinking problem. Again I ask... can you last for over 24 hours without saying an unkind word to or about somebody?

Within a matter of just a minute or two we can create damage that might take years to correct, if ever. Unkind words wound more than we realize, they hurt more than we care to admit and they are impossible to take back. No matter how old or how young we are we have no right to insult, we have no right to be rough. We have no right to criticize and no right to gossip. Sometimes it isn't even what we say but the tone we say it in... "Did you hear?!"

Children are often cruel through words. They will laugh at someone who is not like them and will call them unkind names. And yet it is not only children who do this, we, adults much too often do the same. Sometimes we camouflage our mockery but the pain this inflicts is very much the same. We might as well carry a sword and cut people physically for the pain is often just as great. His feet are too big... her hairdo is funny... look at how fat she has gotten... she doesn't know how to dress well... he is too cheap... she is much too young for him... I can go on forever... Yes, name calling can hurt very much, If you call a person "stupid" often enough, they might learn to believe you. What a cruel thing for one person to do to another! How often cruel words are thrown in so called jest, yet if it's unkind, it hurts and no humor can make an unkind word kinder. Much too often words that are not very kind are found in families. We are tired or impatient or simply feel that when we are at home and relaxed, rules need not apply. And yet - home is where kindness should start! This is where children learn basics! It is from our home that kindness should be carried to the rest of the world.

History shows us that words used unfairly have often promoted hatred. Verbal assault is powerful enough to damage people's lives and careers. Whichever the case, we leave victims behind. We can wound and kill through words and this is so wrong!

Every habit is difficult to break and new ones are difficult to begin. Let us give this some serious thought! Perhaps if we try very hard, we can train ourselves to think before we speak. Perhaps if we can choose our words and use them to soothe rather than to wound, to build rather than to break down and to bring happiness rather than sadness, the world will be a better place not only for others, but for ourselves, as well!

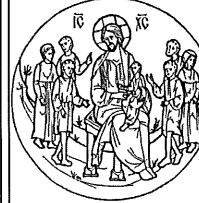

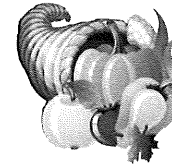
