Cute, but still something to be said for it! Interesting imagery!!

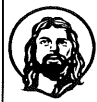

**Why such a big amount in Occupancy Cost?** Occupancy Cost consists of building repair & maintenance, water & waste, contract labour, electricity, insurance, natural gas and property taxes. All these expenses are within line except for our building & maintenance. If you look around you will see many improvements such as energy efficient windows, energy efficient lighting, fresh painted hall, soon an updated kitchen and much more. Just as in your own home you need to keep the building safe, clean, refreshed & energy efficient. We have saved for most of these projects but the accounts are starting to get low again. 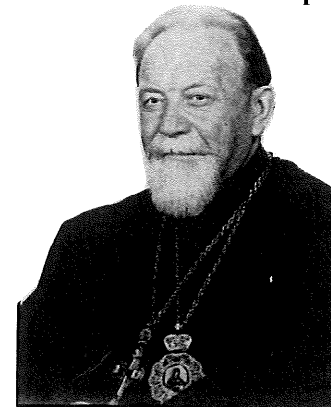
