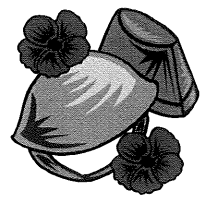

Dear Parishioners and Guests,

**Canada's 94th Remembrance Day** will be solemnly observed on Monday, November 11, 2013. With deep respect, Canadians will be remembering those who fought or who sacrificed their lives for our freedom in the First and Second World Wars, the Korean War and in peace-keeping in the Middle East, Cyprus, Vietnam, and Afghanistan. We will also be remembering those who were the victims of war including the disabled and bereaved. We are truly indebted to them all.



All their efforts were made for **peace** in the world or in individual countries. The word "peace" means more than just an end to war or conflict. The Hebrew word **shalom** offers us a deeper insight into what these heroes fought for. Shalom (peace) means a condition of perfect harmony, serenity, prosperity, happiness, and peaceful relations among people. In Psalm 122, King David sings, "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem." He is asking not only that Jerusalem be spared from war or strife, but that every good gift descend on the city.

Throughout the gospel we see **Christ bestowing peace** on his disciples, just as He does at the Last Supper: "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." (Jn 14:27)

**Our Divine Liturgy is a celebration of peace.** The service begins with the priest's announcement: "Blessed be the kingdom of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." It is the perfect beginning, for the liturgy is a doorway into the kingdom of God, where peace rules.

**Peace is the precondition of worship.** It means that we are to assume a disposition of inner peace during the Divine Liturgy. We are to rid our minds of all distractions, worldly cares, all hostile feelings towards any other person, and all personal anxiety. We are to center our minds and hearts on the presence of God.







The first series of petitions is called the "**ektenia of peace.**" Here 'peace' refers to every possible blessing: salvation, unity, plentiful food, favorable weather, good will among nations, and relief from hard times.

From both the Gospel and the Liturgy we learn that **peace is** much more than a principle, theory, political program, or social ideal. It is **Christ himself**, whose coming as **the Prince of Peace** we will be celebrating in less than 2 months.

Among the things that Christ did not say in the sermon on the mount is, "Blessed are those who prefer peace, wish for peace, await peace, love peace, or praise peace." His blessing is on the **makers of peace.** He requires that we assume an **active role** rather than a passive role in the pursuit of peace.

Unfortunately, for most people, peace is not the Kingdom of God, but a slightly improved version of the world we already have. We, however, can only get rid of conflict by eliminating the factors-spiritual and material, that create division. So, embracing all who offered their lives for us, **we pledge to uphold their sacrifice for us by being good and loyal peacemakers.**

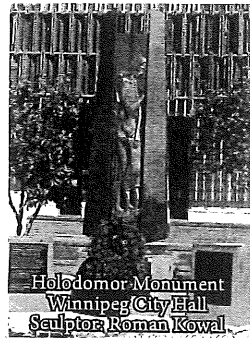
