*Dear Beloved of St. Joseph's and all Guests,*

All of us, sooner or later visit a doctor's office. Older people feel that they see doctors more often than the younger ones, which is probably true, but unfortunately there are many young people who also have to spend much time in waiting rooms which try their patience to the limit. I thought of this last week when, someone shared with me their visit to the **Lord's Clinic:**

*"I went to the Lord's Clinic to have my routine check-up and I confirmed that I was ill. When Jesus took my blood pressure, He saw I was low on tenderness. When He read my temperature, the thermometer registered 40 degrees of anxiety. He ran an electrocardiogram and found that I needed several "love bypasses" since my arteries were blocked with loneliness and could nourish my empty heart.*

*I went to orthopedics, because I could not stand by my brother's side and I could not hug my friends since I had fractured my bones when tripping with envy. He also found that I was short-sighted and could not see beyond the shortcomings of my sisters and brothers.. When I complained about deafness, the diagnostic was that I had stopped listening to Jesus' voice talking to me on a daily basis. When time came to prescribe medication, Jesus said that every hour I must take one pill of patience, one cup of brotherhood and one glass of humility. Not a day should go by that I not take a large dosage of love. Before going to bed, I must never forget to take two caplets of clear conscience. Also, I must never give in to sadness or desperation for this can be very contagious and I must make sure not to pass this along to others."*

What would OUR diagnosis show if WE were to visit the Lord's Clinic? Would we be given the same method of treatment? Are we also running a high fever of anxiety and have blocked arteries that do not allow us to love properly, and fractured limbs that keep us from standing beside those who need us? Are we also short sighted or cannot hear very well? These are maladies that sooner or later touch each and every one of us- so why don't we give in to treatment before it's too late!



Today we have special envelopes for a Collection in support of Met. Sheptytsky Institute where our future priests and lay people are being educated- please be generous!

Also next Sunday, may we also be charitable to help all the suffering people in the **Philippines** – over 2 million people have been sadly devastated by the Cyclone. 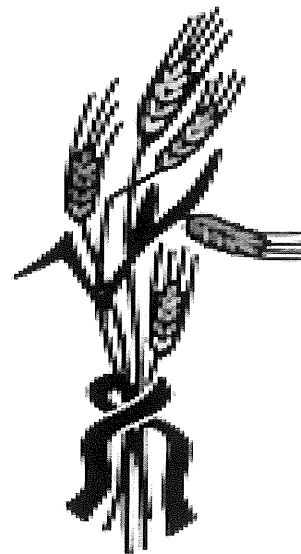

#### **National Holodomor Awareness Week November 18 - 24, 2013**

80 years have passed since famine raged through Ukraine eradicating the lives of millions of children, women and men from one of the world's most bountiful lands.

This was Holodomor, the Ukrainian famine-genocide of 1932-1933

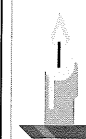
In the early 1930s, in the very heart of Europe - in a region considered to be Europe's breadbasket - Stalin's Communist regime committed a horrendous act of genocide against the Ukrainian people. An ancient nation of agriculturists was subjected to starvation, one of the most ruthless forms of torture and death. The government imposed exorbitant grain quotas, in some cases confiscating supplies down to the last seed. In many villages special troops were brought in to gather any and all food that could be found. The territory of Soviet Ukraine and the predominantly Ukrainian-populated Kuban region of the Northern Caucasus (Soviet Russia) were isolated by armed units, so that people could not go in search of food to the neighbouring Soviet regions where it was more readily available. The result was the **Ukrainian genocide of 1932-33**, known in Ukrainian as the **Holodomor**, or extermination by famine.

#### **The Denial**

- The Soviet Government refused to acknowledge to the int'l community the starvation in Ukraine and **turned down int'l offers of assistance**.
- Welsh journalist Gareth Jones first alerted the world in 1933 to the rampant starvation in Ukraine.
- Walter Duranty of the New York Times set the tone for most of the Western press coverage with authoritative denials of starvation. However, Duranty conceded off the record: "as many as 10 million may have perished."

#### **The Numbers**

- The 1931 harvest was 18.3 million tons of grain.
- The 1932 harvest was 14.6 million tons of grain.
- The 1933 harvest was 22.3 million tons of grain.
- The Soviet regime dumped 1.7 million tons of grain on the Western markets at the height of the Holodomor, and Ukrainian villagers were dying at the rate of 25,000 per day.
- Children comprised 1/3 of the victims! Large numbers of children were orphaned and became homeless.
- The Ukrainian population was reduced by as much as 25%.
