Dear Parishioners and Guests of St. Joseph's.

So many of us are closely following the developments that are taking place in **Ukraine**. At times, we are optimistic and/or very pessimistic! The news changes by the minute, or so it seems, and what I write tonight maybe totally 'off the wall' in an matter of hours! So may I touch upon another subject that may be of interest to us..

I've come across some very interesting quotes on the **path to Happiness** from the secular press and I wish to share some of this, not of course, in no way diminishing our Christian belief that **Jesus** Who died and resurrected for us ensures us the true path to happiness, not only in our earthly life, but an eternal life in the presence of our God Who truly loves us so very much and welcomes us into His Heavenly Kingdom.

Sometimes when we are feeling down, the words of others can lift us up. A great atheistic philosopher John Stuart Mill offers us his words of wisdom addressing how to be happy: *"Those only are happy who have their minds fixed on some object other than their own happiness: on the happiness of others, on the improvement of mankind, even on some art or pursuit, followed not as a means, but as itself as ideal end. Aiming thus at something else, they find happiness by the way."*

What makes each of us happy varies from one person to the next, but this quote seems to hit home on the most important concepts of living a happy life.

I keep a file of quotes to remind me of basic fundamentals that are easy to forget. Here are some on the subject of striving happiness and personal fulfillment:

"Catch a passion for helping others and a richer life will come back to you." William Danforth also said that we have a tendency to sit in front of a fire say: *"Give me heat and then I'll throw in the wood."* But a fireplace doesn't work that way – neither does life! If you help and bless others, a richer life will naturally come back to you.

"The secret of happiness is freedom and the secret of freedom is courage." thus spoke Thucydides, an ancient Greek philosopher. Courage is the ability to do things that you fear; things that make you feel uncomfortable & help you find out more about yourself.


It takes courage to try new things, but it is only in trying new things that we grow. It is our growth and fulfillment as human beings that brings happiness and guides us into the Heavenly Kingdom to which Jesus has ultimately invited us.

Winston Churchill, even during the most trying times of war, stated: *"A pessimist sees the difficulty in every opportunity; an optimist sees the opportunity in every difficulty."* Problems exist in every life; not a day goes by without a problem. We can choose to let that thought weigh us down, or see it as the challenge of living a happy life. How about you?

Let us continue to pray for our sisters and brothers in Ukraine to have the courage and strength to overturn a corrupt dictatorial government...

Fr. Mark Miller, CSSR

A native Westerner, born in Edmonton, Fr. Mark Miller studied in Winnipeg, Toronto and Germany before completing his doctorate in moral theology (1992) at the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana.

After receiving his doctorate, Fr. Mark was appointed the director of the newly formed *Redemptorist Bioethics Consultancy* and spent 16 years as a clinical bioethicist working at and out of St. Paul's Hospital in Saskatoon, SK.

Dr. Miller has taught and provided workshops at Catholic Colleges, in adult formation programs, for Catholic teachers, and many health care practitioners.



He is now the provincial of the English-speaking Redemptorists of Canada. He continues his clinical ethics work part-time at the Centre for Clinical Ethics at St. Joseph's and St. Michael's Hospitals in Toronto.

Fr. Miller has a particular passion for parish nursing and for palliative/hospice care and the ethical issues that surround care for the dying. He is the author of two books and numerous articles on Bioethics.

Fr. Mark still plays hockey so that many frustrations are left on ice rather than given (generously) to others!

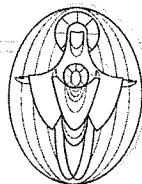
