\*Ladies Bible Study will be held Thursday morning at 10 AM. All ladies are invited to lunch in the Fellowship Hall after the B. S. is done.



Fr. Miller has a particular passion for parish nursing and for palliative/hospice care and the ethical issues that surround care for the dying. He is the author of two books and numerous articles on Bioethics.

# A Warm Welcome to Fr. Taras Kchik, CSsR




This weekend -February 15 & February 16, we wish to welcome newly ordained Fr. Taras Kchik, CSsR to St. Joseph's Parish.
