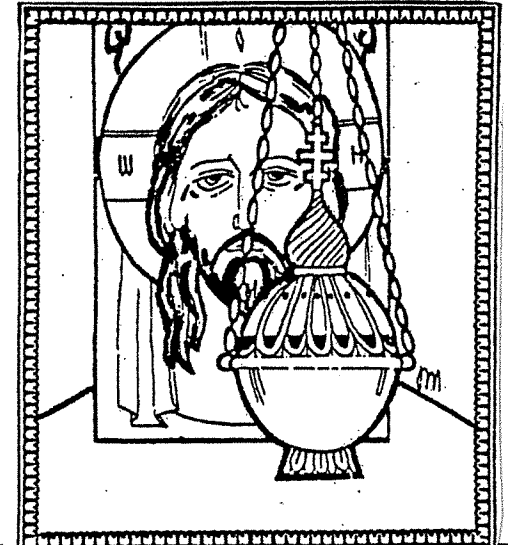

Today's culture downplays commitment and accountability. As a result, many shop for a local church or just don't see the need for joining one. But, there are several reasons why we need a church family.

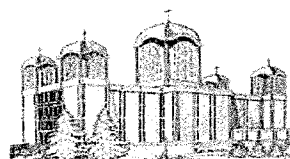
