

We sincerely wish to extend the warmest gratitude and our love to Father Jack Kingsbury CSsR who truly has blessed us with a most delightful and inspiring Mission. His wonderful sense of humour and his deep-abiding faith emenated forth as he meaningfully shared the Word of God each evening. His penetrating insights into many of Jesus' stories and parables made the Gospel very much alive and relevant. God has gifted you, Fr. After we sing the special hymn at the end of Liturgy, everyone is encouraged to proceed to the *tetrapod*, pay homage and kiss the cross as a sign of faith and gratitude to Jesus who suffered and died for us! *Dear parents*, show your children this holy prayerful custom which has been part of our religious tradition for over 1000 years....

"FAST from anger and hatred! Give your family an extra dose of love each day!

"FAST from discouragement! Hold on to Jesus' promise that He has a perfect plan for you.

"FAST from complaining! When you find yourself about to complain, close your eyes and recall some of the little moments of joy Jesus has given you!
"FAST from resentment and bitterness! Work on forgiving those who hurt you!

"FAST from spending too much money! Try to reduce your spending by 10%,

and give those savings to the poor!

March 25th THE ANNUNCIATION TO THE MOTHER OF GOD



The joy of the Incarnation finds its first expression in the Icon of the **Annunciation**. The Icon brings to us and helps us enter into the "Good News of Grace". Everything in the Icon leads to and is centered in the Mother of God. The very posture of the **Archangel Gabriel** is depicted in graceful motion as if dancing, holding in his left hand a staff, the ancient symbol of the messenger. His right hand is extended toward the Mother of God in both greeting and communication.

The **Mother of God** herself is portrayed in a unique position. It is said that at the time of the Annunciation, she was occupied with spinning. Thus, the ball of thread in her hand dropped as if forgotten in her surprise at the appearance of the Angel and the weightiness of his message. The latter element which explains the prudent, perplexed reaction of the Mother of God, conveyed here by the hesitant genture of her hand, and expressed over and over by the hymns of the Feast. In poetic exuberance the Church enters into this mystery:

"Why does your figure blaze with fire;" said she, whom we venerate, to Gabriel in her amazement. "What is your rank and what is the value of your words? You announce to me that I shall bring forth a child, yet I have no experience of man. Lead me not astray with crafty words, as the crafty servant once led Eve." Vespers

The Mother of God accepts the message of the Annunciation and is thus shown with her head inclined in consent. She humbly agrees, "I am the servant of the Lord, let it be done to me as you say." (Lk. 1-38) The Icon celebrates the Virgin's agreement to be the mother of the Incarnate Son of God. One final detail of this Icon remains to be told: the ray of light descending on the Virgin illustrate the message of the Angel, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you," (Lk 1:35)

Prescribed as a pictorial element for the Royal Doors of the Iconostas, the Icon is among the simplest to have ever been developed. It stands out to us as as the sign of God's love and man's freedom. The clarity of its expression, and the plenitude of its inner joy have remained throughout the ages. The Icon remains permeated with joy, and the words of the **Troparian** of Feast becomes our song of joy!

TROPARION: "Today is the fountainhead of our salvation and the revelation of an eternal mystery: the Son of God becomes the Son of a Virgin, and Gabriel announces the good news of this grace. Therefore, let us join with him crying out to the Mother of God: 'Hail, Full of Grace, the Lord is with you!"

Please closely examine the Annunciation Icon on our Iconastas Royal Doors!


