 May I again express my heartfelt gratitude for your active participation in the **Holy Week** and **Easter** services! Today, i.e., Sunday at the 11:00 am Divine Liturgy we happily celebrate our parish's **First Solemn Holy Communion**. 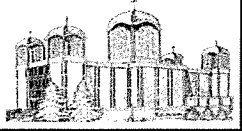
Let us all refocus on the **Joy**, the **Love** and the **Peace** of the **Resurrected Jesus** and the promise of **Life Eternal** for each of us!
