Dear Parishioners and Guests,

We mentioned in last Sunday's bulletin that all of us Ukrainian Redemptorist priests will gather for our annual Chapter meeting here at St. Mary's Monastery in Yorkton. Fr. Jack Kingsbury, our American CSsR, whom we all know has joined us to challenge us to examine more closely our philosophy, our policies and our pastoral challenges.








It actually is very good and enjoyable to be with all our religious brothers – from Saskatoon, Ituna, Yorkton and Winnipeg. Gone are the days when we had foundations in Toronto, Newark, Washington, Roblin and Wynyard. We sadly no longer serve these parishes or communities. Long gone are the days when we Ukr. Redemptorists numbered in the 40's and we were much younger and more energetic. Seven of that number had become Bishops – Michael Hrynchyshyn for France, Michael Bzdel as Metropolitan of Canada, Michael Kuchmiak for England, Michael Wiwchar for Chicago, (*then we ran out of 'Michael's'*), Peter Stasiuk for Australia, John Pazak for Toronto and finally, Bryan Bayda for Saskatoon – all from our little company of Ukr. Redemptorists! And then many of our confreres have been called to their Heavenly reward and thus we are left with some 14 confreres. Even some of these are retired since they are in their 80's! Those of us in our 60's and 70's are still trying to pull our share of the load! Happily God has blessed us with much desire and some energy too!

As a religious Province, we have created a Mission statement to challenge us and whereby to evaluate our purpose and goals. It is rather broad, but each of our ministries must relate to it and, God willing, fulfill this CSsR mandate: ***“We are Redemptorists missionaries living (the) Byzantine spirituality in the context of the Ukrainian Catholic Church. Through apostolic community in collaboration with others, we witness Christ, the Redeemer, by preaching the Word of God (Good News) to the poor and most abandoned.”***

In other words, ***Welcome Home***, the ***Shrine*** and our ***Parishes*** must fulfill every aspect of this ***Vision***. We do believe we are, but we are very much aware that we can do more with our limited personnel. We do realize that we truly need the strong laypeople's ***'collaboration'***. We therefore will be strongly encouraging more and more ***parishioners*** to become more actively involved with us for our pastoral programs to succeed!

Next spring the Yorkton Province must make difficult decisions of how we can make best use of this ***'personel'*** and transfer our limited men into the best position for the good of our greater church. Some may remain in the positions they are, but obviously, there will be a need to assign confreres to new and challenging new posts. Pray for us!

May I wish all of you a wonderful week and since it's pouring here in Yorkton as I compose this, I catch myself praying for blessed weather in Wpg!

# The Descent of the Holy Spirit

**T**HE FESTIVAL of Pentecost has its roots in the Old Testament. It began as a harvest feast and later added the giving of the Law of Moses on Mount Sinai as the "harvest" of the Old Covenant. Our Christian Feast of Pentecost is celebrated on the fiftieth day after the Resurrection of Christ. On this feast the Descent of the Holy Spirit effected a New Covenant. It was precisely this descent of the Spirit which revealed to the world the knowledge of the mystery of the Holy Trinity, consubstantial, undivided and yet distinct. It was the fulfillment of the revelation concerning the Persons of the one God as three.

The Icon of Pentecost is a marked contrast with the biblical description of the Descent of the Spirit. The Book of Acts of the Apostles (2:2) records that "suddenly from up in the sky there came a noise, like a strong, driving wind which was heard all through the house where they were seated." In contrast, the Icon is characterized by serenity and composure. The postures of the Apostles reveal serenity. All of them are seated, some gesturing as if in subdued conversation with one another. The gift of

the Holy Spirit remains the inner life of grace. The event of Pentecost forms the Church and is the inauguration of the Kingdom of God.

The twelve Apostles form a semi-circle to express the unity of the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church. They are pictured in an inverse perspective — their figures grow larger as they recede into the background. The centre place which is unoccupied is reserved for Christ, the invisible head of the Church. Some ancient icons symbolize Christ's invisible presence with an altar, the throne of His glory.

The Evangelists are shown holding books; another has a scroll as a sign of having received the gift of teaching. Above the semi-circle, beyond the edge of the panel, there is a symbol of heaven from which rays or tongues of fire descend. This is a sign both of sanctification of the Apostles and Disciples, and of their baptism with the Holy Spirit and fire.

The world, to which the Apostles would preach, is represented at the bottom of the Icon by one symbolic figure of a king. He known as "Cosmos" as he represents the whole world enveloped by sin. He sits in a dark place since the whole world had formerly been without the light of faith. He is bent over to show he was made old by the sin of Adam. Through the power of the Holy Spirit the twelve Apostles brought light to the whole world by their teaching.

The Icon of the Descent of the Holy Spirit represents the great event of sanctification which took place in the apostolic community. At the same time, it is an expression of the sanctification of our lives in the Church by the Holy Spirit Who is constantly glorified: "Treasury of Blessings and Giver of Life."

Prayer — Heavenly King, Comforter, Spirit of Truth, You are everywhere present and fill all things. Treasury of Blessings and Giver of Life, come and dwell within, cleanse us of all stain, and save our souls, O Gracious Lord.

## ЗШЕСТЯ СВЯТОГО ДУХА

(І. С.) — Зшестя Св. Духа (Зелені Свята) пригадують нам, що 50-го дня по Воскресенні Святий Дух зійшов на апостолів і перетворив їх на відважних проповідників Євангелії. Вони поширювали по усім тодішнім світі навчання нашого Спасителя Ісуса Христа. Святий Дух завершив духовний вишкіл Христових апостолів. Він зійшов на них у виді вогняних язиків, щоб зазначити, що проповідування Христової Євангелії це головне завдання місіонерів.

Це дуже старинне свято, бо християни святкували його вже від апостольських часів. Воно зветься у нас „Зеленими Святами”, бо є звичай у нашому народі у цей день прикрашувати зеленню доми й церкви.

В дні Зшестя Святого Духа родиться і починає діяти Христова Церква. Св. Дух провадить, просвічує, освячує і зберігає на дорозі правди.

Празник Зшестя св. Духа заслуговує на особливу увагу з огляду на історію богослуження та значення. Головний мотив святкування для новозавітньої Церкви — це подія приходу св. Духа на апостолів. Це радісна, урочиста й важлива подія. З богослужби цього Празника прийшла до наших щоденних молитов нам добре знама молитва до св. Духа: „Царю небесний...” Цією молитвою починаємо кожне наше богослуження.

Цвіти й зелень дерев є ознакою життя, тож стали символом життєдайности св. Духа. Як природа на весну оновлюється зеленню і квітами, так і св. Церква і її вірні оновлюються силою св. Духа.

Дари св. Духа великі й щедрі. Св. ап. Павло каже: „Плід Духа: любов, радість, мир, довготерпіння, лагідність, доброта, вірність, тихість і здержливість” (Гал. 5,22-23).

Св. Дух зійшов і на нас у св. Тайні Миропомазання зі своїми дарами й помазав нас на Христових борців, а наше тіло зробив своїм храмом. На що правду звертає нам увагу св. Павло й наминає нас, щоб ми після неї жили: „Хіба ж не знаєте — каже він — що ваше тіло — храм св. Духа, який живе у вас? Його ви маєте від Бога, тож уже не належите до себе самих” (І Кор. 6,19).

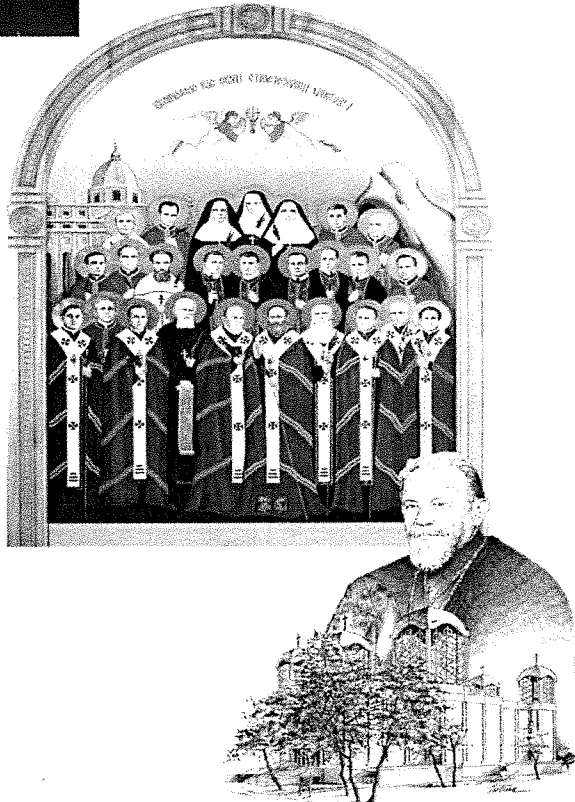
