You were wondering?.....ARCHBISHOP.....ARCHEPARCHY

Ever wonder whether the syllable "arch" should be pronounced with the 'ch', as it is in "church" (soft) or as it is in "archive" (hard) ??

Here is the rule:

When 'ch' is followed by a consonant, the 'ch' is usually soft - as in "Archbishop - soft 'ch'

When 'ch' is followed by a vowel, the 'ch' is usually hard - as in "Archeprarchy" - hard 'ch'

And, finally, in Archeprarchy, the **emphasis is on the 'e'**, not on the last 'a'.

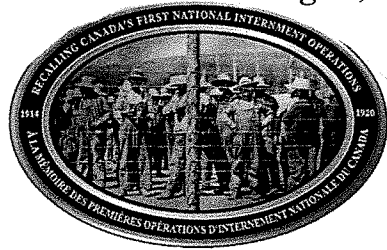

TWENTY-SEVEN DAYS TO GO TO CTO

Only **27** days remain before project CTO (meaning *One Hundred*) happens across Canada with a "wave" of plaque unveilings from coast to coast, at **11 a.m.** (local time), on **Friday, 22 August 2014**. Starting in Amherst, Nova Scotia, and ending in Nanaimo, British Columbia, two of the **24** sites where Ukrainians and other Europeans were imprisoned as "enemy aliens" during Canada's first national internment operations of 1914-1920, this is the first-ever time in Canadian history that **100 plaques** have been unveiled on the same date and time across the country.

Commenting, UCCLA's chairman, Roman Zakaluzny, said: *"To hallow the memory of all of the internees of the Great War period in Canada we came up with the idea of unveiling 100 plaques across Canada, literally from coast to coast, on the 100th anniversary of the passage of the War Measures Act, which provided the legal framework for the needless internment of thousands of innocent men, women, and children, and the registration of many tens of thousands more as "enemy aliens," not because of any wrong they had done but only because of who they were, where they had come from. This national commemorative exercise should bring to mind not only what happened during the First World War but also how the very same War Measures Act would be used against our fellow Japanese, German, and Italian Canadians in the Second World, and in Quebec in 1970. We should all be reminded of the need to remain ever-vigilant in defence of our civil liberties and human rights, esp., in periods of domestic and international crisis."*
