Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

Yesterday I accidentally came across my Pastor's message to Holy Eucharist parish in Toronto back on this day in 1994. In an attempt to revive a 'diminishing and dying' parish, many changes needed to quickly take place – two come to mind: 1. the need for more English and 2. the urgency to change the Julian calendar to the Gregorian – if we hoped to keep the young couples and have a future in the parish. May I share some of the thoughts I had then composed:



From the Pastor's Desk

“Often we want too much or we want it all! A little of this, a little of that or all of this and all of that – at the same time! Like standing at the fork in a road – do we take this path or that? Or standing still, and saying, “But I want both!” And often we don't move – we stand still (actually this is a decision!) and we go No Where!!! We truly are the losers!”

“We do this (too often!) in our private lives or even in the church. Rather than decide, we often spend our time looking back (to where we were!) and failing to see the future (where we could or should be going!) Do we creat new, innovative plans to ensure a positive growth or do we lament how much better things were in the past? Where, for example, will this parish be in five years if we continue “to do things like we always have...? Will we still be alive?”

“For example, we live our 'double lives' - our secular life and our religious life; our work-life and our church-life; our play-time and our prayer-time; our daily calendar and our liturgical calendar. Do these conflict or do they harmonize with each other? How much do the latter influence the former? Is our Church (each of us must ask!) a 'MUSEUM' where we experience the past or a 'LIVING LIGHT' to guide us today, tomorrow and forever – like for eternity? Each answer is important”

I recall that some of the parishioners took great offense to the above and claimed I (of all people!) was a radical and was disturbing their comfortableness in the church. Well, we did introduce more English and the New Calendar and did keep many young people active in the church and it happily prayerfully continues...

Summer is quickly slipping by. Let us enjoy the blessings that God has so generously bestowed upon us! And truly let us never stop giving **thanks** for God's goodness to each of us!

May your joys be many, your happiness ever heavenly!
