### THE FEAST OF THE PATRONAGE OF THE MOST HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

The most popular Marian feast day in the Ukrainian Church is the Feast of the Patronage of the Most Holy Mother of God which is observed on Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> according to the Gregorian calendar and Oct. 14 according to the Julian calendar. Although it is not a major feast day, however, it has become a favorite Marian feast day among the Ukrainian people. The reason for this is because devotion to the Blessed Mother of God evokes sentiments of hope and confidence in her powerful intercession in times of temptation and danger.

This feast reminds us of an event that happened at Constantinople in the beginning of the 10th century. During the reign of Emperor Leo the Wise in the year 911, the Saracens besieged the capital city of Constantinople. The terror stricken people gathered in the church of the Most Holy Mother of God at Blachernae for an all-night prayer vigil.

Among the people gathered in church that night were St. Andrew and his disciple, Epiphany, who prayed for the protection of the city. During the vigil service St. Andrew saw the Most Holy Mother God in radiant light approaching the royal doors of the iconostas to the main altar, accompanied by St. John the Baptist and St. John the Theologian along with a great choir of saints singing beautiful hymns. The Blessed Mother knelt before the altar and prayed for a long time. Later she arose, removed the bright veil from her head and stretched it out wide over the people in church. Then the vision disappeared.

St. Andrew and his disciple saw the vision and understood that the Mother of God came to rescue the inhabitants of the city. Upon hearing this news the inhabitants were filled with joy and hope that this was a sign of their deliverance. Indeed, the enemy soon retreated and the city was saved. Since that time the feast of the Patronage or Pokrova, as it is called in Ukrainian, has come to be celebrated in the Eastern Church. The Greeks ceased to celebrate this feast after the fall of Constantinople to the Turks in 1453. The veil became the symbol of the protection and intercession of the Blessed Mother.

Let us remember that Mary not only gave birth to Christ, our Redeemer, but also participated in the work of redemption, especially when our Lord was dying on the Cross on Good Friday. St. John relates, "Seeing his mother and the disciple he loved standing near her, Jesus said to his mother, 'Woman, this is your son'. Then to the disciple he said, 'This is your mother'. (John 19: 26)." Ever since she has not ceased to intercede for her beloved children before God.

During the Moleben service to the Blessed Mother we sing: "Gracious Lady, you pray for all those who with faith take refuge in your powerful protection. We sinners ever in misery and affliction have no other recourse to God than you. We are burdened by many sins, O Mother of God. We bow down before you; save your servants from every calamity." This hymn reflects the confidence which our people place in the prayers and intercession of the Blessed Mother.
