We have been blessed with the presence of Dr. Fr. Mark Miller, a RC CSsR'er who is one of Canada's leading authorities on Medical Ethics. He is a consultant at numerous hospitals across Canada as he strives to educate doctors and nurses on major moral life and death issues. We Ukrainian Redemptorists have been the fortunate recipients of his vast knowledge on genetic issues, be they in vitro, stem cell research, cloning, but especially on the topics of Euthanasia or Physician-assisted Suicides and the dangers that accompany the new legislation that is being introduced by our Canadian governments.



Blessed Omelian Kovch (born 20 August 1884 in the village of Kosmach — died 25 March1944 at Majdanek) was a Ukrainian Greek-Catholic priest murdered in the Majdanek Nazi death camp.

He was born in a peasant family in the town of Kosmach in the Kosiv region of Western Ukraine, and was ordained in 1911 after graduating from the Sts. Sergius and Bacchus College in Rome. He served as a parish priest from 1921 to 1943 at the church of St. Nicholas in the village of Peremyshliany, and was the father of six children.

In the spring of 1943 he was arrested by the Gestapo for harbouring Jews, specifically for providing Jews with more than 600 baptismal certificates. On 25 March 1944 he was gassed at the Majdanek concentration camp near Lublin, Poland.

On 9 September 1999, the Jewish Council of Ukraine awarded him the title of one of the "Righteous of Ukraine".

His beatification took place on 27 July 2001 in Lviv, during the Divine liturgy led by Pope St. John Paul II.

On 24 April 2009 the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church solemnly proclaimed Blessed Priest-martyr Omelian Kovch "Patron of Clergy".

In 2010 the Winnipeg Jewish Community honoured Blessed Omelian Kovch at a Survivors and Heroes Event.

This November, Holy Eucharist Parishioners are pleased to enshrine the beautiful stained glass windows, prepared by Prairie Stained Glass of Winnipeg, in their place of worship.
