Vision 2020 - "The Vibrant Parish" - Stephen Sumka

Three regional sobors (workshops) on this theme were held in Manitoba – one in Dauphin and two in Winnipeg. On Oct. 25th, Blessed Virgin Mary Church hosted some 55 participants from numerous city parishes (*in which St. Joseph's members participated*) for a full day of talks, discussions and presentations.

After the Divine Liturgy, Fr. Michael Kwiatkowski opened the day with a talk of the 'state of the union' from the Archeparchy's perspective and the importance of listening to the input of all parishes for our Church to go forward.

In groups, we discussed and brainstormed the six priorities:

- Serving One's Neighbours (*reaching out to those in need*)
- Holy Mysteries (Sacraments) and Prayer
- The Word of God (*knowing and living the Bible*)
- Leadership (*training and supporting good leaders in the parish*)
- Fostering and Serving Unity (*better collaboration within our parishes*)
- Missionary Spirit of the Parish Community

Each group initially was to prepare a top ten list for each of the priorities, but due to time, it was limited to five. Each group presented their position to the assembly.

Presentations were provided by a pastoral assistant, a woman religious and an university student. This provided food for thought and a series of questions.

Group Discussions on *GPS – where do we go? What route do we take?*

I was pleased to report as a result of my participation that St. Joseph's Parish is on the right track with meeting the objectives of a vibrant parish. As a parish we are moving in a positive direction with programs that are in place and plans for the future. Some examples are:

- Active Parish Council with a leadership program
- Catechism Classes for Children and Adults
- Youth Group Program
- Parish Organizations: UCWLC, Knights of Columbus, Seniors Club, Choir
- Church volunteers: Altar Servers, Epistle Readers, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers
- Outreach – program for less fortunate
- Activities: perogy days, praznyk, fellowship, movie night, dance classes, etc.
- Engaged Clergy

As a parish, we are welcoming new people and always engaging with fellow parishioners to ensure everyone feels they belong.

A FORMAL REPORT on all three sobors will be provided by the Archeparchy to illustrate the direction and the mandate that our Church will endeavor to fulfill.
