

FRIENDSHIP

It has been said that if you have but one good friend, you are truly blessed, more than one, you are doubly blessed. I feel a friend should be cared for as a rare flower, sprinkled with kindness, nourished with love and never, never taken for granted.

Friends are one of the most precious gifts in life. How lonely it would if we had no friends to share our joys, comfort us when we are blue, and listen, really listen to us when we talk. We can be completely ourselves, never needing to stand on ceremony because there is an unspoken bond between us. Troubles are halved when shared with friends, and burdens are lightened because they care; they truly enrich our hearts.

Friendship means generously extending ourselves to others, always striving to make new acquaintances. As the flowers in our garden are all unique in their own way so, too, are the different friends we meet. Each friend contributes something to us in life.
