This was said by a little girl. I was about to bless a home of a young family. Before sprinkling the holy water throughout the house, I led opening prayer. When I reached the part that referred to Jesus' "presence", the little girl looked up at me and said "presents?" This was a very innocent and authentic response. Just a few weeks ago this little girl found many gifts under her family's Christmas tree just for her. The joy and happiness connected with such an event was not easy to forget.

All of us have those moments that have brought us joy and happiness. We remember them fondly. Some of these memories may focus on a gift but most likely the focus is on the person connected with the present.

Currently we are in the liturgical season known as "Pylypivka" which helps us to prepare for the Nativity of Our Lord. Its helps us to have contact with the Giver of all gifts, our God, who loves us beyond measure. When our ancestors forgot about the Giver of all gifts, He could not stay away from us. They were in darkness. By sending his Son at Christmas His mission of bringing us back to his Presence began.

During the forty days of Pylypivka, we encounter important feast days. Yesterday, November 21, was the feast of the Presentation of Mary in the Temple. In a nutshell, this holy day leads to recall how Mary was presented by her parents in the temple, so that she could encounter the presence of God.

May I suggest the following: Call upon Mary during your journey through Pylypivka. She, who became the Mother of God, can certainly help us to encounter the presence of God. Gaze upon the Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and in particular notice how Mary is holding the Christ Child. She is not tightly embracing the child. Mary is presenting. She is holding the child out to us, hoping we will receive our Lord and His redeeming love for us. As this happens, I am sure that like that little girl, we too, will raise our heads and say in our own special way, "Presence".


