## Matthew 25 Stops

Dear Parishioners,

Ready or not, here it comes.

Great Lent is just around the corner. It begins on February 8.

Today is called "Meatfare" Sunday. The reason for its name is as follows: in the past, on this day people, would begin to fast from meat. It was time to say "farewell" to meat until Easter.

After reflecting on the Gospel for today, the parable of the Last Judgment (Matthew 25:31-46), this day could also be called "*Care Sunday*". It is always important to evaluate how we have been *caring* for our brothers and sisters. *Caring* is an action that we should never say "farewell" to.

One blogger on the internet writes about Pope Francis's *Matthew 25 Stops*, such as, visits to a prison, a nursing home, and a soup kitchen. The Pope has personally taken up the works of mercy. One thing that could be said about the *Matthew 25 Stops*, is that the Holy Father, who certainly has a busy schedule, *cares*. He takes the time to show God's mercy to all. This is certainly a wonderful example for us to follow.

With these words, Pope Pius IX entrusted the **Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help** to the Redemptorists. In 1866, the Icon was placed in the church of St. Alphonsus in Rome for veneration by the faithful and from there devotion to Our Mother of Perpetual Help spread throughout the world. The year 2016 is the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this moment. A Jubilee Year to honour the Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and to celebrate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary began on June 27, 2015 and continue until June 27, 2016. 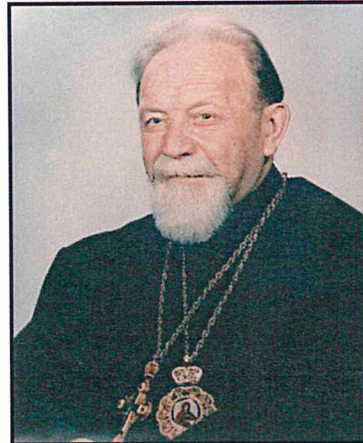
