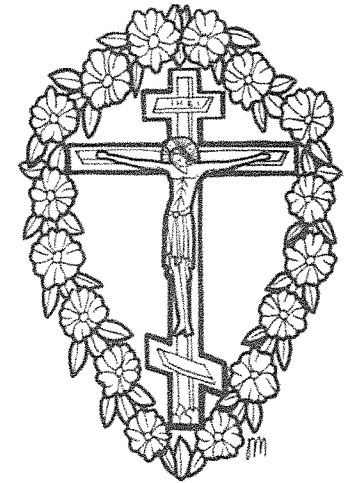

### ***To Your Cross, O Master, We Bow in Veneration***



The Third Sunday of Great Lent commemorates the Holy Cross on which our Savior Jesus Christ died. The death and the Jesus Christ opens the possibility of "eternal life" for us after we fall asleep in the Lord. By His death, our Lord, God and Savior, Jesus Christ redeemed our souls. This Sunday is the middle point of this holy season (Great Lent) of prayer, fasting, and charity in preparation for the Feasts of Feasts Holy and Glorious Pascha. Archbishop Joseph Raya has written, "Every major effort brings pain and fatigue. Discouragement sometimes appears before the work is done. Since now, with the grace of God, we have reached the mid-point of Great Lent, and lest we be overcome by its burdens, the Church, our compassionate mother, reveals to us the Cross of Christ as a source of power and inspiration, as the support of the just and the hope of the sinner. The Cross is planted in the midst of Great Lent like the Tree of Life in the midst of Paradise, like the Rod of Moses in the midst of the camp, in order that anyone looking upon it may find health, strength and the courage to pursue his course."

### ***Patience in Abundance***

There's no doubt about it, we live in a world of wanting things now. We have no patience. Having to wait at a red light annoys us; being stuck in a slow moving line frustrates us. If our internet connection isn't working or is too slow, we get angry. We don't want to have to wait for things. We demand instant results and we want them now.

It can be the same when it comes to our relationship with others and with ourselves. If a relationship is in difficulty, we can be tempted to give up on it. If things start to go wrong for us personally – maybe there are problems at work or a project isn't working out – we can feel like quitting.

So also our relationship with the Church and with God. Scandals in the Church can leave us angry, disappointed, and inclined to walk away. When God is slow to answer our prayers or doesn't seem to answer them at all, we can be tempted to stop praying or to forget God altogether.

We may be impatient but patience is something that our God has in abundance. Over and over again in the scriptures we find God forgiving his people, giving them yet another chance, even when they don't deserve it, even when they keep letting God down.

How God deals with us is how we are to live. Jesus is our great model of perseverance. People resisted his message, but he remained committed to doing the will of his Father. He never gave up. As Christians, we are called to persevere on our faith journey, however difficult. Great Lent is a good time to work on becoming more patient.

*Be patient: with yourself. Life is the school of patience.  
Be patient with the Church. It is a broken, pilgrim Church.  
Be patient in prayer. Don't expect instant answers.  
Be patient with others. Most people are trying their best.  
Start again whenever you feel like giving up or throwing in the towel*
