On Monday June 27, we celebrated the 15th Anniversary of the Beatification of Blessed Vasyl Velychkovsky, C.Ss.R.

Also, we closed the Jubilee Year honouring the icon of our Mother of Perpetual Help commemorating the 150th anniversary since this icon was entrusted to the Redemptorists to make her known throughout the world.

During this day of prayer Fr. Mary Gnutel preached 4 sermons commemorating these two events in the context of the Jubilee Year of Mercy.
He used the acronym COFFEE – **Christ Offers Forgiveness For Everyone Everywhere.**

After lunch a film on the Way of the Cross which was held in Lviv in April 2016 which integrated the life of Blessed Vasyl into each station, was shown to all the pilgrims. After the evening Liturgy, which was celebrated by Metropolitan Lawrence, the crowd of some 150 people processed to the Chancery and back, praying the rosary and singing hymns.

The day was very prayerful and uplifting for all those who attended. We thank all those who participated in the day and all those who contributed to make this event possible: the clergy, the singers, servers, shrine staff, volunteers and the kitchen staff.

In 1866, the Icon was placed in the church of St. Alphonsus in Rome for veneration by the faithful and from there devotion to Our Mother of Perpetual Help spread throughout the world. The year 2016 is the 150th anniversary of this moment. Our Mother of Perpetual Help, save us. Amen.*
