Jubilee Year of Mercy

Concludes on Sunday November 20

During this Jubilee Year, everyone is invited to experience God's Mercy. All are encouraged to make a "pilgrimage", especially by entering the Holy Door and receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation. By making a "pilgrimage", one's heart is more open to receive the blessings and graces of God's Mercy.

Since the fifteenth century, a Holy Door or Porta Sancta has been used as a liturgical symbol for conversion of heart. Pilgrims pass through the holy door as an expression of leaving behind and crossing the threshold from sin to grace, from slavery to freedom, and from darkness to light. For the Christian, the door derives its meaning from Jesus Christ who is the door, the gate, "the way" to life (Jn 14:6).
