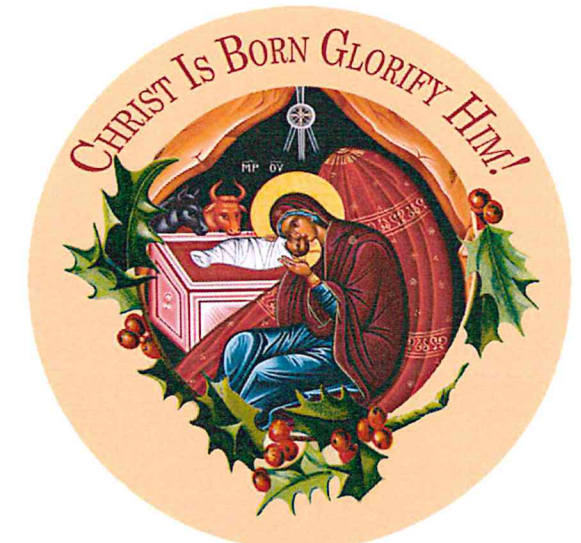

## From the Pastor's Desk

**Христос Раждається!**

**Christ is Born!**

On this Sunday there is a variety of themes to reflect upon.

First of all, for most of the world, the focus is on the New Year. Out with the old and in with the new. It is an opportunity to begin again. Whether it is in person, by phone, or by social media, it is a time to wish one another the very best in this new year of 2017. Please reach out to someone today and say "Happy New Year."



Liturgically this Sunday has many sides. This day is both the *Sunday after the Nativity* and it is the *Sunday before Theophany (Epiphany)*. The events of the birth and baptism of our Saviour are important moments in the mission of Jesus Christ to save all of us. On

Thursday, January 5 at 7:00 pm,  
we celebrate Theophany (Epiphany) the  
Baptism of Our Lord with Divine Liturgy and the Solemn Blessing of Water.

This is a major event. Please plan to attend. If you are unable to attend on Thursday evening, there is another Divine Liturgy for the feastday on Friday morning at 8:30 am.

Today, January 1, is also the feast day of the Circumcision of Our Lord. In the Gospel of Luke, we read that *"after eight days had passed, it was time to circumcise the child; and he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb"* This is the day that Jesus was named according to Jewish traditions. Jesus, whose holy name simply means "to save," lives as "God-made-flesh" who is not so much interested in dominance as in making the ordinary holy. This includes us. During this year, may we grow closer to God. And as this happens, we grow in holiness.

This day is also the feast of St. Basil the Great. He was a bishop and was an authority on the monastic life. Why was St. Basil given the name "Great"? He was called "Great" because he conquered the hearts and souls of many for Jesus Christ. The clergy at our neighboring parish of St. Nicholas are members of the Basilian Order. They serve according to the charism of their founder St. Basil. Please remember them in your prayers today.
