

## Christ is Born!



Dear Parishioners,

The phrase *the best seat in the house* usually refers to a place to sit in a theatre for a movie, play or a concert, that is comfortable and provides a great view.

In today's Gospel, we hear about *the best seat in the house* being up a tree. It may not have been comfortable but it did provide a good view. Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus so much that he climbed a tree. There he found the best seat to see Jesus. In order to get there Zacchaeus had *to go out on a limb* in several ways, which eventually lead to an encounter with Jesus that changed his life.

Today is known as *Zacchaeus Sunday*. It is the first of the Pre-Lenten Sundays, whose purpose is to get us ready for the start of Great Lent, which begins on February 15. As we travel through the time of Pre-Lent and Great Lent let us keep in mind that we may be called to go out a limb like Zacchaeus did, which will certainly provide *the best seat in the house*, which is always next to Our Lord.

## 32nd Sunday after Pentecost– January 17, 2021 Sunday of Zaccheus

**Tropar, tone 8:** You came down from on high, O Merciful One,\* and accepted three days of burial\* to free us from our sufferings.\* O Lord, our life and our resurrection,\* glory be to You.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen!

**Kondak, tone 8:** When You rose from the tomb,\* You also raised the dead and resurrected Adam.\* Eve exults in Your resurrection,\* and the ends of the world celebrate Your rising from the dead,\* O most merciful One.

**Prokimen, tone 8:** Pray and give praise to the Lord our God.

**Verse:** *In Judea God is known; His name is great in Israel.*

**Epistle:** A reading from the first Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to Timothy. (1 Tim. 4:9-15)

Timothy, my son! You can depend on this as worthy of complete acceptance. This explains why we work and struggle as we do; our hopes are fixed on the living God who is the savior of all men, but especially of those who believe. Such are the things you must urge and teach. Let no one look down on you because of your youth, but be a continuing example of love, faith, and purity to believers. Until I arrive, devote yourself to the reading of Scripture, to preaching and teaching. Do not neglect the gift you received when, as a result of prophecy, the presbyters laid their hands on you. Attend to your duties; let them absorb you, so that everyone may see your progress.

**Alleluia Verses:** *Come, let us rejoice in the Lord; let us acclaim God our Savior.*


*Let us come before His countenance with praise and acclaim His with psalms.*

**Gospel: Luke 19:1-10**

At that time when Jesus was passing through Jericho. There was a man there named Zaccheus, the chief tax collector and a wealthy man. He was trying to see what Jesus was like, but being small of stature, was unable to do so because of the crowd. He first ran on in front, then climbed a sycamore tree which was along Jesus' route, in order to see him. When Jesus came to the spot he looked up and said, "Zaccheus, hurry down. I mean to stay at your house today." He quickly descended, and welcomed him with delight. When this was observed, everyone began to murmur, "He has gone to a sinner's house as a guest." Zaccheus stood his ground and said to the Lord: "I give half my belongs, Lord, to the poor. If I have defrauded anyone in the least, I pay him back four-fold." Jesus said to him: "Today salvation has come to this house, for this is what it means to be a son of Abraham. The Son of Man has come to search out and save what was lost."
