

Dear Parishioners

Several times this past week, the weather forecast called for the *risk of frost*. This possibility of below freezing temperatures was not good news to those who have already put in their gardens. Most likely, after hearing this, gardeners were probably motivated to take some type of preventative actions, like covering certain vulnerable plants. The threat of frost also caused big box stores with outdoor garden centres to move the plants inside for the night. These simple efforts prevented possible loss.

Everyday, we must be aware that there is always the *risk of frost* to our relationship with God and with others. When we become mad, agitated, or annoyed, there is a chance we will become very upset. In other words, *frosted*. As followers of Christ, during these moments, it is so important that we turn to God in prayer, so that any *risk of frost* will not turn into a possible *cold war*.

During our Divine Liturgy, we pray the words, *let us lay aside all earthly cares*. In other words, we are called to place, not cover up, all cares and worries of life into the hands of God. This includes the frost that is threatening our hearts, such as hurt, pain, and disappointment. These experiences are often too heavy for us to carry by ourselves. Fortunately, the hands of God are able to carry our earthly cares. Also, once we place our cares and worries in God's hands, we will be pleasantly surprised with the results. We will be able to face any type of obstacle, even if at first glance it may appear to us as too much to handle. Once we place it in the hands of the Lord, anything is possible.

## All Saints Sunday - Sunday May 30, 2021

**Epistle:** A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (Heb. 11:33-12:2)

Brothers and Sisters! All who by faith conquered kingdoms, did what was just, obtained the promises; they broke the jaws of lions, put out raging fires, escaped the devouring sword; though weak they were made powerful, became strong in battle, and turned back foreign invaders. Women received back their dead through resurrection. Others were tortured and would not receive deliverance, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Still others endured mockery, scourging, even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, sawed in two, put to death at sword's point; they went about garbed in the skins of sheep or goats, needy, afflicted, tormented. The world was not worthy of them. They wandered about in deserts and on mountains, they dwelt in caves and in holes of the earth. Yet despite the fact that all of these were approved because of their faith, they did not obtain what had been promised. God had made a better plan, a plan which included us. Without us, they were not to be made perfect. Therefore, since we for our part are surrounded by this cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every encumbrance of sin which clings to us and persevere in running the race which lies ahead; let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, who inspires and perfects our faith.

**Gospel: Matthew 10:32-33, 37-38, 19:27-30**

Whoever loves father or mother, son or daughter, more than me is not worthy of me. He who will not take up his cross and come after me is not worthy of me." Jesus said to them, "I give you my solemn word, in the new age when the Son of Man takes his seat upon a throne befitting his glory, you who have followed me shall likewise take your places on twelve thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. Moreover, everyone who has given up home, brothers or sisters, father or mother, wife or children or property for my sake will receive many times as much and inherit everlasting life. Many who are first shall come last, and the last shall come first.

# St. Joseph's Church Maintenance Issues & Projects (during Covid-19)

Dear Parishioners,

Even though activity at St. Joseph's has been greatly reduced for over a year, maintenance of our church property has been very active. Below is a summary of what has taken place, as well as future projects. As always, thanks is extended to all parishioners for your generous support over the past year and for your offerings as we continue to journey through this time of the pandemic.

**Improved lighting has been added to the exterior of the Church & Rectory**

**Fire Suppression system upgrade for the kitchen oven/stove was completed this year at a cost of \$4,342**

**New gas shutoff valve in Kitchen is now required as the existing old one is leaking. Total cost for this change out is approximately \$800.**

**Additional kitchen renovations have been completed or are underway in order to obtain a Food Handling Permit from the Province of Manitoba. These are as follows:**

- Repair loose baseboards – now complete
- Paint kitchen washroom where walls were repaired – now complete
- Repair any walls in kitchen area that are damaged – in process
- Degrease stove/ oven surfaces – now completed
- Change out ceiling tiles to solid ones (no holes) – in process (estimated cost \$1,500)
- Check all cooking/food utensils for wear or damage. Replace as necessary
- Apply fresh coat of paint to kitchen area (estimated cost \$400-\$500 materials with volunteer labor)



## Security of Church Building & Property

- As a result of an exterior break-in to our Boiler Room & theft of the laptop used in monitoring our Boiler & A/C systems, deadbolt locks & security plates have been added to several exterior doors at a cost over \$1,000.
- One additional door still has to be done. Note: Alarm system scared off intruder before any additional items were stolen or damaged.
- New gate & fencing added between Church and garage on west side. (\$1,517.83)
- Additional fencing improvements will be undertaken during 2021. (\$3,915.10)

## On Going Maintenance issues for Church Building & Property

- Boiler Room roof needs to be redone to prevent water leaks during rain
- Street level access area to elevator requires wall and floor repair
- Sidewalk paving stones need levelling
- Auditorium stage requires new lighting
- Paint on Domes is peeling & requires attention
- Front steps & ramp needs repair
