

Dear Parishioners,

A certain priest served his religious order in the area of leadership for years. In addition to being Provincial Superior for several terms, he also served in a variety of administrative positions. Recently, he was assigned as the pastor of a very large parish.

After several months, someone asked him, "what is your typical day like?" He answered, "Everyday is filled with interruptions."

Interruptions are usually unexpected. How we handle them is so important. Often God will use such moments and our responses to them for his goodness to flow.

Twenty years ago this month, St. Pope John Paul II visited Ukraine. A major highlight of the visit was the beatification of a number of martyrs of our church. In other words, their faith filled responses to the harsh interruptions in their lives, were noticed. Also recognized was how God's grace flowed through them to strengthen other believers who were also suffering. The heroic holiness of these people in the face of harsh interruptions were now officially recognized by the universal church.

When we read about the lives of the saints, one common thing that is easily noticed is how their lives were interrupted by the unexpected. Instead of seeing such disturbances as obstacles to living their lives, they became an opportunity for holiness. In other words, an interruption can bring us closer to God. Let us try to take advantage of such opportunities when they arise.

I will leave you with the lyrics from a song called "God is Good" by Jonathan McReynolds. These words certainly contain much food for thought regarding "interruptions".

May your struggles keep you near the cross. And may your troubles show that you need God. And may your battles end the way they should. And may your bad days prove that God is good. And may your whole life prove that God is good.

Epistle: A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (2: 11-18)

Brothers and Sisters! He who consecrates and those who are consecrated have one and the same Father. Therefore he is not ashamed to call them brothers, saying, “I will announce your name to my brothers, I will sing your praise in the midst of the assembly”; and, “I will put my trust in him”; and again, “Here am I, and the children God has given me?” Now since the children are men of blood and flesh, Jesus likewise had a full share in ours, that by his death he might rob the devil, the prince of death, of his power, and free those who through fear of death had been slaves their whole life long. Surely he did not come to help angels, but rather the children of Abraham; therefore he had to become like his brothers in

every way, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest before God on their behalf, to expiate the sins of the people. Since he was himself tested through what he suffered, he is able to help those who are tempted.

Alleluia Verses: *All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord. All the families of the nations shall fall down before him.*

Gospel: John 3:13-17

The Lord said: “No one has gone to heaven except the One who came down from there — the Son of Man who is in heaven. Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that all who believe may have eternal life in him. Yes, God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him may not die but may have eternal life. God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.”

“May Christ our true God, through the intercessions of His all-pure Mother; of the holy, glorious, and praiseworthy Apostles... and of all the saints, have mercy on us and save us, for He is good and loves mankind.” (Dismissal, Divine Liturgy)

This seemingly-obvious fact is often repeated in our church-services, – that God is “good” and loves us. We need to be reassured of this fact, again and again; that He, indeed, loves “us.” That is to say, He loves the people “we” are now, as we are, with all our strengths and weaknesses. I need to embrace this astonishing truth, again and again, so that I can see myself as God does, both honestly and mercifully. In the inimitable words of Thomas Merton, “...The man who is not afraid to admit everything that he sees to be wrong with himself, and yet recognizes that he may be the object of God's love precisely because of his shortcomings, can begin to be sincere. His sincerity is based on confidence, not in his own illusions about himself, but in the endless, unailing mercy of God.” Help me, Lord, be good to myself, as You are to me.
