Synod of Bishops of the UGCC 2023 to take place in Rome

According to the press service of the Secretariat of the Synod of Bishops of the UGCC, the Decree states that "due to the hostilities in Ukraine caused by the massive invasion of Russian occupying forces, in accordance with the decision of the Synod of Bishops of the UGCC held in the city of Przemyśl from July 7 to 15, 2022, with the consent of the members of the Permanent Synod of Bishops of the UGCC obtained during the 3rd (74th) session held on March 8-10, 2023, and with the consent of the Apostolic See, and in accordance with canons 103 and 106, § 2 of the Code of Canons of the Eastern Churches, by the authority of the Major Archbishop of Kyiv-Halych of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church," the Synod of Bishops of the UGCC is convoked to Rome from September 3 to 13, 2023.

The main theme of this year's Synod will be "Pastoral Care for the Victims of War."

The Decree also indicates that all bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church are invited to participate, as they have an urgent obligation to do so by virtue of church law and their oath.

The Decree was published on May 17, 2023, on the official website of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church.

Sunday of the Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council

On this Sunday the Church commemorates the Fathers (Bishops) of the First Ecumenical Council. Persecution of Christians ceased during the fourth century, but heresies (false teachings) arose. One of these heresies was Arianism. Arius was a priest of Alexandria. He falsely taught that the Savior is not consubstantial (the same essence) with the Father, but is only a created being. In the year 325, 318 bishops representing Christian Churches from various lands gathered together at Nicea (present day Iznik, Turkey) to counter this false teaching. The Fathers of the Council declined to accept a Creed proposed by followers of Arius. Instead, they affirmed the Creed (Symbol of Faith) that we are familiar with. Saint Constantine asked the Council to insert into the text the word "consubstantial," which he had heard in the speeches of the bishops. The Fathers of the Council unanimously accepted this suggestion. In the Nicene Creed, the holy Fathers set forth and confirmed the Apostolic teachings about Christ's divine nature. The icon of the Sunday of the Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council depicts Saint Constantine together with the Bishops who attended the Council and affirmed the unity of the Faith through the Nicene Creed. The Fathers are shown holding the text of the Creed, also referred to as the Symbol of Faith.
