Dear Parishioners,

This coming week is filled with great events for our Ukrainian Catholic Church. First on the feast of St Michael, the archangel, November 8, we will celebrate the episcopal ordination of Bishop-elect Michael Kwiatkowski. It will take place at the Cathedral of St. Volodymyr & Olga at 6 pm. Fr. Michael is a native of Manitoba. He attended high school at St. Vladimir's College in Roblin, and studied for the priesthood in Rome. Later he got his degree in Canon Law. When our church became free in Ukraine, he spent many years at

the Ukrainian Catholic University in Lviv in the pastoral department. Retuning to Canada, he became the Chancellor or our Archeparchy, pastor of Holy Eucharist and recently pastor of Blessed Virgin Mary. Now he will be the Bishop of New Westminster in British Columbia. Don't miss this opportunity to be part of this celebration and ordination.

On the next day in Peremysl, Poland, our deacon Ivan Dzhur, C.Ss.R. will be ordained to the priesthood. Fr. Ivan was born in Ukraine. After completing high school, he began discerning a vocation to religious life. He first spent time in England with a community in Northern Scotland. He worked in Bristol, England at the airport managing a ground crew (baggage handlers and cleaning crew). Then he met us and came to Canada to pursue his formation to be a Redemptorist. After spending some time at The Welcome Home, he took his studies in the Bronx, New York, in Poland and in San Antonio, Texas. We will be welcoming our new priest, Fr. Ivan on November 18th for his First Solemn Divine Liturgy at 5 pm. (his Prymitsia) It is customary to receive a special individual priestly blessing at the end of the Liturgy. Again he will be part of this celebration. There will be a reception after the Liturgy on Saturday.

This Saturday, on Remembrance Day, the Ukrainian Knights of Columbus of Winnipeg will have a Divine Liturgy at 9:30 am followed by a Remembrance Day commemoration at our church of St. Joseph's. All are welcome to participate in this event. A reception will follow.

Don't forget to come a volunteer at the Perogy Bee next week November 14th & 15th. We do need more volunteers, especially for the clean up after and for various jobs in this perogy making process.

Feast of St. Michael the Archangel - November 8

The Feast of the Archangel Michael and the holy Angels indicates to us the significant role the Angels play in our salvation. Before the Lord God created man, He created the holy Angels who are invisible, immortal, perfect beings and pure spirits. Throughout our lives, our guardian angel watches over us, protects us, inspires us, warns us against sin, and intercedes for us before God. From this comes our duty to venerate the holy Angels, to praise them, and to thank them every day for their assistance and protection. The praise of Saint Michael stems from the fact that in defense of God's glory he led all the good angels against the rebellion of Satan (Revelations 12:7-9). He is depicted both as a military leader clad in full armor and as a minister wearing the deacon's sticharion.
