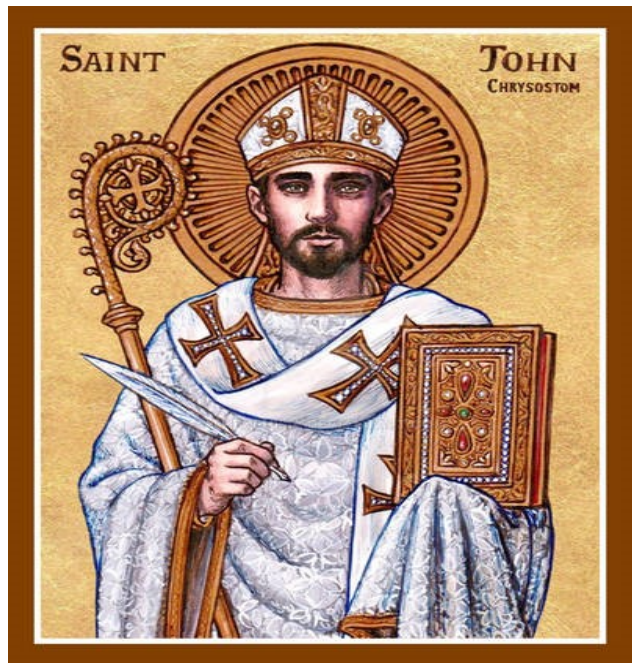

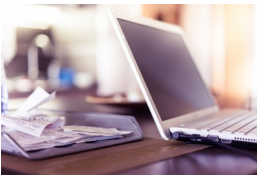

## Feast of St. John Chrysostom - November 13

Our father among the saints, John Chrysostom (347-407), Archbishop of Constantinople, was a notable bishop and preacher from the fourth and fifth centuries in Syria and Constantinople. He was born in Antioch of noble parents: his father was a high-ranking military officer. He is famous for eloquence in public speaking, his denunciation of abuse of authority in the Church and in the Roman Empire of the time, and for a Divine Liturgy attributed to him. He had notable ascetic sensibilities. After his death he was named *Chrysostom*, which comes from the Greek, "golden-mouthed." The Church honors him as a saint (feast day, November 13) and counts him among the Three Holy Hierarchs (feast day, January 30), together with Saints Basil the Great and Gregory the Theologian.
