Pastor's
Desk*



Dear Parishioners:

This weekend finds me again in Saskatoon. For many years now (20+) I have been involved in teaching at a lay formation program for Ukrainian Catholics in Saskatchewan. Saskatchewan had a two-year (10 weekends a year) program, teaching a select number of laity the Christian faith. Many Ukrainian Catholics have gone through this program and are now leaders in the various parishes.

Some have gone on to become priests, deacons and sisters. Unfortunately, here in Manitoba we have had no such program. It is my wish to begin (or renew) something in our parish to help mature us in our faith. I could use some help in organizing this.

The Church offers us a yearly time of renewal - Pre-Lent and Lent or the Great Fast (Великий Піст). We see in our church the sign posts which are pointing to the icon of the Resurrection. On the sign posts are the themes given to us by the five Pre-Lenten Sundays: Desire, Humility, Coming Home, Love and Forgiveness. These themes follow us throughout the Great Fast. They remind us of the prerequisites that we need to make spiritual progress - to become more aware of God's mercy and love and to become more loving (Christ-like) to our neighbours. Hopefully we will have a short mission this year. We prepare ourselves so that we can worthily celebrate Holy Week and Easter. This year Easter falls on March 31st.

English classes for new-comers have resumed this past week. I thank all those who have volunteered to help in tutoring our new Ukrainians.

Sorokousty began this past Saturday (Feb 3) when we prayed for all of the deceased of our Parish. Our Church offers us 5 such All-Souls Saturdays: one before Lent before the Gospel of the Last Judgment, three during Lent and one before the feast of Pentecost. Please inform the parish office of any new names of the deceased in your families you wish to be added or if you have not given any names then please forward them to us.

Next Sunday is Forgiveness Sunday. We will inaugurate the Great Fast with the celebration of Forgiveness Vespers. During this service we enter in the spirit and time of Lent by forgiving each other. Also during this service the church is transformed from light to dark, the colour of this season.

A big thank you to all who are facilitating Coffee Klatch. It is very successful. A real time of fellowship.

Sunday of the Last Judgement

Meatfare Sunday

Fourth Pre-Lenten Sunday

This is the last day of eating meat, traditionally, until Pascha. One week away from Great Lent, we hear the parable of the Last Judgement, the sheep separated from the goats—goodness rewarded and sin punished.

Then the righteous will answer Him, *‘Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? And when did we see You a stranger and welcome You, or naked and clothe You? And when did we see You sick or in prison and visit You?’*

And the King will answer them, *‘Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you did it to me.’*

The previous pre-lenten readings have been leading to this image of the final exam time, as it were, when the teaching, reminders, and mentoring end, and our performance is evaluated. What is the metric for a passing grade?

This Sunday’s story tells us plainly that the one criterion by which Christ will judge us is love; love for our neighbour is love of God. Sin is the absence of love. Do we live in love or not? Your (my) humanity develops and thrives only because you have been and continue to be loved. Cruelty, criminality, hunger, and want emerge from a lack of love; caring for others, is how we manifest the Kingdom of Heaven here on earth. This parable tells us that Christ is present not only in our fellow parishioners, family, or friends—He is in every human being, even those most in need. Let’s reach out to Him at every opportunity and, like the father of the prodigal last week, let’s celebrate being home.
