

From the Pastor's Desk Dear Parishioners:

This weekend we commemorated and prayed for the people of Ukraine who are suffering greatly because of this unjust war. In our times we are seeing the face of evil as it tries to destroy our people. This face is ugly and does not have respect for human innocent life, nor for the dignity of the human person. Its motive is power and greed and nothing will get into its way. The Ukrainian people are

bravely and courageously defending their homeland. In the recent weeks, because of political squabbles in foreign countries, Ukraine now lacks arms and equipment to be successful. Again these political squabbles are not taking into account the value of other people. Ukraine is seen as a foreign far-away conflict. The politicians are more concerned about their own "troubles" and maintaining their power. We are all God's people and we need to care and help each other, especially in the struggle against an evil force. May we as people or connections with Ukrainian ancestry not be complacent but let us rise up and do what we can to help Ukraine.

We continue our journey of Great Lent. Let us not let Lent slip through our hands and do nothing. The prayer of St. Ephrem (in this bulletin) is one prayer that we can practice daily throughout the week. There are the special liturgical services - Presanctified Liturgy and the Way of the Cross. If we make the effort, we will be spiritually rewarded. Otherwise before we know it, we will be eating paska, but our spiritual lives will remain hungry.

March 17 is our Annual Parish Meeting. I encourage all of our parishioners to gather and be part of this meeting and become involved in the planning and the projects of our parish community. More than ever we need each other. Our Ukrainian Catholic world in Winnipeg is entering a new phase of its life as we have so many new Ukrainian immigrant/refugees here in our city. They need the support and the spiritual care that our Church can offer.

Have a great week! I'll be in Toronto for Redemptorist meetings all week. So you will be in the capable hands of my assistants.

## Sunday of the Paralytic



Today's Gospel message carries several important lessons for our journey to salvation. The first is that we must come to Christ to be healed of our spiritual sicknesses. Christ did not just heal the paralytic but He also forgave his sins, which was more important.

Secondly, just as the paralytic's friends helped him, we as the Body of Christ need to help one another. The passage stresses that it was not the faith of the paralytic alone that made him well. Only when Jesus saw "their faith" did He forgive his sins and heal him.

Thirdly, we can think of prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and obedience as the four friends that help us come before Christ and be healed.

Attention Alumni of St. Vladimir's College. You are invited to a Reunion.






#### ST. JOE'S PEROGY BEE Next Perogy Bee is March 5th and 6th!

**O God**, cleanse me of my sins and have mercy on me. **I have sinned** without number, forgive me, O Lord. (*making twelve bows*)

(Once more the entire prayer of St. Ephrem is recited With one prostration at the conclusion.)
