We have now completed the fourth week of the Great Fast, a time for spiritual renewal in preparation for Holy Week and Easter. For whatever reason, our Lenten services this year have not been well attended. There are still two weeks left. This week, besides our regular services of Way of the Cross on Sunday (Ukrainian) and our Presanctified Liturgy on Wednesday, we have a very special service on Friday evening. Instead of the Way of

the Cross, we will be celebrating a **special service in honour of the Mother of God**. This commemoration is always celebrated on the 5th Saturday of Lent, or in our case on the Friday evening. Please make time to be part of this beautiful service.

Next week March 18,19 & 20th will be a Tri-parish **LENTEN MISSON**. Each evening will be a new sermon, built on the previous sermon. The theme is Encountering the Trinity preached by our own Fr. Ivan Dhzur, C.Ss.R. The Mission begins each evening at 6:30 p.m. Monday evening at Michael's Parish located on Yale Ave. in Transcona; Tuesday evening at St. Anne's Parish in East Kildonan and Wednesday evening will be here at St. Joe's . Note that that evening the Presanctified Liturgy will begin at 6:30 p.m. The Mission is a wonderful opportunity to be fed spirituality, an opportunity for confession and some fellowship. Please plan to attend.

We have had successful Perogy Bees the last few times. I thank all who organize it and take part in it. There will be one more Perogy Bee before Holy Week. Again thank you.

Our Annual Meeting (AGM) is next Sunday March 17th after the 11:00 a.m. Divine Liturgy. Please plan to attend and become acquainted with the work of our parish and our parish complex. This is your church. We thank your for all the support you have given it throughout the year.







Blessing of Easter Foods

HOW TO PUT TOGETHER A TRADITIONAL EASTER BASKET





PASCHA - The Easter Bread (Pron. Pa-ska.) A sweet yeast bread rich in eggs, butter, etc. Symbolic of Christ Himself who is our True Bread. Usually round loaf baked with a golden crust decorated with a symbol indicative of Christ. Sometimes a cross (+) of dough is placed on top encircled by a plait given it a crowned effect or Greek CHEESE - (Rusyn: Hrudka or Sirec) A custard type cheese shaped into a ball having a rather bland but sweet taste indicative of the moderation that Christians should have in all things. Also creamed cheese is placed in a small dish and both are decorated with symbols (see Pascha) out of cloves or pepper




HAM - (Rusyn: Sunka - pron. shoon-ka.) The Flesh meat popular with the Slava as the main dish because of its richness and symbolic of the dish because of its richness and symbolic of the prefer Lamb or Veal. This is usually well roasted or cooked as well as other meats so the festivity of the day will not be burdened with preparation and all may only the Feast.



SAUSAGE (Rusyn: Kolbasi-pron. kol-bus-i.) A spicy, garlic sausage of pork products indicative of God's flavor and generosity.



BUTTER - (Rusyn: Maslo pron. ma-slo.) This favorite dairy product is often shaped into a figure of a Lamb or small cross and decorated as the cheese. This reminds us of the goodness of Christ that we should have toward all things.







EGCS (Rusyn: Pisanki pron. pi-sun-ki) Hardboiled eggs brightly decorated with symbols and markings made with beeswax, indicative of new life and resurrection. Red eggs are also traditional date back to a story with 5t. Marry Magdalens. Having been dyed with onion skins saved over the past Christ's bloot. The color of life and victory that came through Christ's bloot.





HORSERADISH (Rusyn: Chrin pron. khrin) Horseradish mised with grated red beets (optional) symbolizes the Passion of Christ still in our minds but sweetened with some sugar because of the Resurrection. A bitter-sweet red colored mixture reminds us of the sufferings of Christ.

These articles are placed in a wicker basket in the control of the blessing. A linen cover usually embroidered with a picture of the Risen Christ or symbol with the words "Christ is Risen" is placed over the food Christ is Risen is placed over the food In some places a large Easter Bread (Pascha) is made and brought separately in a large linen cloth. If the origin of the people was growing acea, a sweet wine may be brought;
