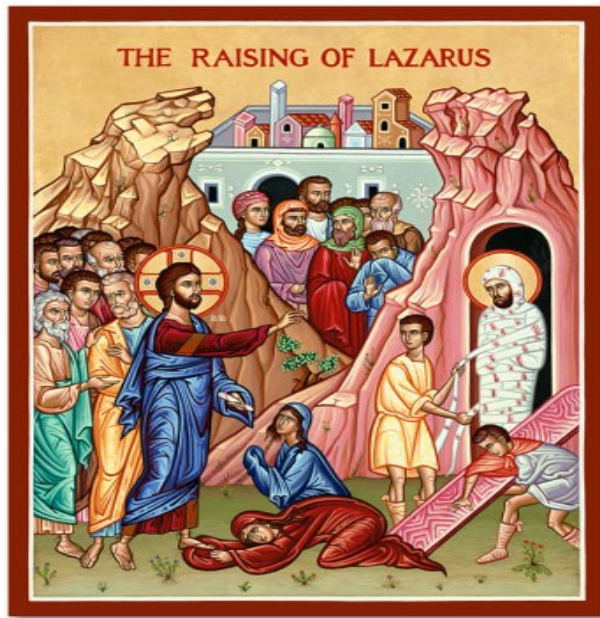

Dear Parishioners:

We have one week before we begin Holy Week - the celebration of the core of our faith. In some sense Holy Week is the most important week of the year in which we travel in prayer through the saving events of our Lord. We begin on Saturday with Lazarus Saturday, a foretaste of the power of our Lord over death as He raises Lazarus from the dead. The next day, Palm Sunday, we welcome our Lord into Jerusalem, into our hearts, where he will complete his saving passion and Resurrection. On Holy Wednesday we will

experience and receive the healing and forgiveness of our Lord through the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. On Thursday we will see the washing of the feet and Jesus preparing for his passion. Then on Good Friday, we will have three services: being present at the passion and crucifixion of our Lord through the reading of the Gospels (Strasty); The Service of the Burial of Jesus (Plashchanytsia); and Jerusalem Matins a mediation on the mystery of Jesus's death burial and resurrection. Holy Saturday we begin with the Liturgy of transformation from dark to Light (Liturgy of St Basil). Then in the evening we explode with song, brightness and life with the celebration of the Resurrection. Please partake of the services as much as you are able. It is worthy coming to all of them.

Today after the 11a.m. Divine Liturgy we will hold our Annual Parish meeting. This is OUR parish. Please be involved and be present and participate in this for the good of our parish. We have several concrete needs. We are searching for a new "operational committee". Especially if you have some experience with mechanical and maintenance of a large building as ours, we could use your help. Also, we are searching for some catechism teachers for this coming fall. This is a beautiful ministry, to pass on our faith to our little ones.

Upcoming events! On April 14th, we will be having an Easter Parish Meal after the 11a.m. Divine Liturgy. Some parishioners have organized themselves to provide this event for us. This is a good opportunity for us to come together as a parish family and share a meal together. Again, I in particular invite all of our new-comers (the new Ukrainians) to share this meal with us.

As you are aware this past year we replaced our air conditioner. This summer we need a new Boiler for the church. Therefore we need to raise some funds. We have invited back AR CASH for a fundraising concert April 26th & 27th Please support our parish and become part of this fundraiser. Thank you.

Church cleaning is Monday morning. Tuesday & Wednesday is the Perogy Bee. And all three days, Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday is the Tri-Parish Mission. It starts at 6:30 p.m. at St. Michael's (Monday), St. Anne's (Tuesday), and St. Joseph's (Wednesday). Please attend all three evenings if it is possible.

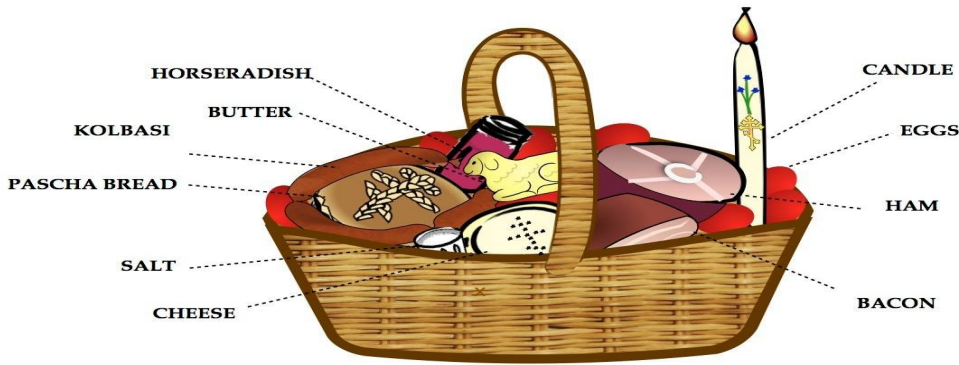

## HOW TO PUT TOGETHER A TRADITIONAL EASTER BASKET

TEXT ADAPTED FROM AN ARTICLE BY FR. BASIL KRAYNYAK, GCU MESSENGER, APRIL, 1979 ILLUSTRATED BY FR. JONATHAN BANNON



**PASCHA** - The Easter Bread (Pron. Pa-ska.) A sweet yeast bread rich in eggs, butter, etc. Symbolic of Christ Himself who is our True Bread. Usually round loaf baked with a golden crust decorated with a symbol indicative of Christ. Sometimes a cross (+) of dough is placed on top encircled by a plait given it a crowned effect or Greek

**CHEESE** - (Rusyn: Hrudka or Sirec) A custard type cheese shaped into a ball having a rather bland but sweet taste indicative of the moderation that Christians should have in all things. Also creamed cheese is placed in a small dish and both are decorated with symbols (see Pascha) out of cloves or pepper balls.



**HAM** - (Rusyn: Sunka - pron. shoon-ka.) The flesh meat popular with the Slavs as the main dish because of its richness and symbolic of the great joy and abundance of Easter. Some may prefer Lamb or Veal. This is usually well roasted or cooked as well as other meats so the festivity of the day will not be burdened with preparation and all may enjoy the Feast.



**BUTTER** - (Rusyn: Maslo pron. ma-slo.) This favorite dairy product is often shaped into a figure of a Lamb or small cross and decorated as the cheese. This reminds us of the goodness of Christ that we should have toward all things.

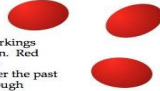


**SAUSAGE** (Rusyn: Kolbasi-pron. kol-bus-I) A spicy, garlic sausage of pork products indicative of God's flavor and generosity.

**BACON** - (Rusyn: Slanina pron. sla-ni-na) A piece of uncooked bacon cured with spices. Symbolic of the overabundance of God's mercy to us.



**EGGS** (Rusyn: Pisanki pron. pi-sun-ki) Hardboiled eggs brightly decorated with symbols and markings made with beeswax, indicative of new life and resurrection. Red eggs are also traditional date back to a story with St. Mary Magdalene. Having been dyed with onion skins saved over the past year, red shows the color of life and victory that came through Christ's blood.



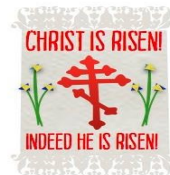
**SALT** - (Rusyn: Sol' pron. sol') A condiment necessary for flavor reminding the Christian of his duty to others.



**HORSERADISH** (Rusyn: Chrin pron. khrin) Horseradish mixed with grated red beets (optional) symbolizes the Passion of Christ still in our minds but sweetened with some sugar because of the Resurrection. A bitter-sweet red colored mixture reminds us of the sufferings of Christ.

These articles are placed in a wicker basket. A decorated candle is placed inside and is lit at the time of the blessing. A linen cover usually embroidered with a picture of the Risen Christ or symbol with the words "Christ is Risen" is placed over the food when brought to the Church.

In some places a large Easter Bread (Pascha) is made and brought separately in a large linen cloth. If the origin of the people was from a wine growing area, a sweet wine may be brought
