

Dear Parishioners,

I hope you are having a wonderful summer. There are many concerns that are upon us. The wild fires do not stop. More evacuees. Perhaps it does not affect us personally, but we must keep them in our prayers and ask God to help and keep them safe and all those

who are on the front lines fighting the fires.

Also, the war in Ukraine continues. It is now three and a half years since it began this last time. Actually, it has been going since 2014. But in recent weeks, it has intensified. We must support the people of this war-torn country. Many of our distant and perhaps not so distant relatives are involved in this war defending their homeland from Russia. It seems everyday innocent people are being killed and many more are wounded. Recently, Lviv was attacked. I was talking (actually praying) with Sister Natalia, who looks after 10 girls at risk, and an orphanage with some 30 orphans, when missiles were flying over head. As we were praying one of them exploded nearby. It was like I was experiencing the war zone (although from a very safe place). The war is real. The destruction is real. The pain and wounds are real. We need to do our part and pray for the end of this war.

Weekly, our Shrine prays for the end of the war on Wednesdays at 1:30 pm. Some people come and join us. I encourage you to take an hour of your day to come and pray with us. Years ago, when Ukraine was still under the Soviet Union, our church had the travelling Icon of our Lady of Pochaviv which went from home to home. The families prayed that Ukraine and our Church in Ukraine would be set free. I believe it is time that we start something similar again for these are desperate times. I will say more about this Icon and our plan of prayer later.

Upcoming, it's the annual August pilgrimage to Cooks Creek. That shrine is also designated as a pilgrimage site for this Jubilee Year. Please take note of the details in the bulletins. Also on September 6, there will be a celebration at Ukrainian Park (north of Gimili on Lake Winnipeg). Details are in the bulletin. I would encourage you to become familiar with this precious park owned by our Ukrainian Catholic Church for the use of all of us. It is a wonderful place – the summer camps took place there. Now in honour of the Jubilee Year an Eparchial event is planned on Saturday September 6. Plan to take part. (See the bulletin on how to obtain tickets for this celebration).
