

Dear Parishioners:

This coming week we celebrate one of our major feast days, the Transfiguration of our Lord (August 6). It is a unique feast day of revelation of who Jesus is and foreshadowing our future. The event happened with a few chosen apostles, Peter James and John on

top of Mount Tabour. Jesus, the man who has been with them for a while now, all of a sudden is changed into a bright light. O voice is heard from the heavens (the Father) "This is my beloved Son, listen to Him." Jesus reveals to the apostles his divinity, as he appears in heaven, so as to give them courage to endure all their earthly sufferings, including Jesus' crucifixion, and not loose hope. That they may know the reality and truth of eternal life. Jesus says to us: "so that you may be where I am." Our baptism and our faithful Christian life promise that we will share in His divinity- our Great Hope. On this feast day we bless fruit. Bring some to Church to have it blessed. This year the evening Liturgy will also be a Healing Liturgy with a special anointing for the healing of our body and soul.

Then just a week later we have our second major feast day of the month – the Dormition of the Mother of God (August 15). This event describes the falling asleep of the Blessed Virgin Mary, her passing from this life. Because of her unique and special role in our salvation in becoming the mother of Jesus, our Saviour, her Son Jesus, takes her body and soul into the heavenly Kingdom of God. In this feast day we see the fulfilling of the promise made at the Transfiguration. She foreshadows our future hope and life. We bring flowers to church to have them blessed as a sign of the beauty of eternal life.

That weekend (August 15-17) is also the annual pilgrimage to Cooks Creek. If you have never been there, it is worth the trip, both to see the church and grotto and to partake in the celebration. Details are in the bulletin poster. Also on Saturday September 6, there will be an Archeparchial celebration at Ukrainian Park (north of Gimli), marking this Jubilee Year. All are welcome. Again, if you have not been there, it is worth the trip. Tickets are needed for the meal. Please see details in the bulletin. (A few tickets are available in the parish office, but please contact Taras Veryha via email at parkdirect@archeparchy.ca if you need for a group).
