

Dear Parishioners:

Our new church year has begun and now we are in the new cycle of feast and fasts. Our first Feast Day is the Nativity of the Mother of God, September 8. In this feast day we celebrate the birth of Mary to Joachim and Anna. She has been chosen by the God the Father to become the dwelling place for His Son, Jesus. We celebrate her because of all Jesus' humanity come

from her alone, since Jesus was immaculately conceived through the Holy Spirit. Through the Birth of Mary a new world order begins to happen. God Himself breaks into human history to transform it and save it from destruction. This feast day fills us with wonder at the marvelous works of our Lord. Let us come and celebrate this event through the Divine Liturgies that will be in our Church.

This past week we again celebrated our Jubilee Healing Divine Liturgy on the first Wednesday evening of the month. It was attended by people from all over Winnipeg, Ukrainian Catholics and Roman Catholics. Many went to confession during that service. It is a great priviledge to be a Jubilee designated site. I pray that more of our parishioners would benefit and participate in this moment of grace.

Our Church community life also begins in earnest this week. A UCWLC meeting will be held Monday. All members please come for this first meeting. We will begin with a prayer service in our church. Tuesday and Wednesday we begin Perogy BEE. Again volunteers are always needed. I thank all those to organize this fundraiser. And I encourage those who perhaps have never participated in the great Bee to come and volunteer, especially on Wednesday morning when the whole production happens. Thursday, another group will be steaming cabbage for future Yarmoroks and the like. It is good to work together for the good of our church and for the good of the charitable acts that we sponsor.

On the following Monday, there will be a church cleaning, preparing for our Praznyk. Years ago, our parish chose September as a Parish Praznyk, since September is "dedicated to "St. Joseph the Worker". Our Praznyk this year will be Sunday September 21st with the 10 am Divine Liturgy, water blessing, anointing, followed by meal prepared by the UCWLC and the Knights of Columbus. Thank you for all your preparation and work.

This week I am all by myself. Fr. Ivan is on his yearly vacation time with his mother and family in Poland. And Fr. Yevhen has journeyed to Slovakia to renew his Ukrainian Passport. With all the recent immigrants, this is difficult to accomplish in Canada.
