Dear Parishioners:

Today our Ukrainian Church celebrates Christ the King. It is a fairly recent feast day established by the Universal Church at the beginning of last century when dictatorships were rising in Europe. The Church wanted to say that the true king is Jesus, who is in

charge of the whole universe. All of our lives are in His hands. Earthy kings demanded loyalty of their subjects. Christ invites us to be loyal to Him and His commandments. The date of this feast day has changed several times. Our Church in Canada celebrates it on the last Sunday of October. Our eastern prayers often refer to Jesus as our King and Lord. Let us always remember that it is Christ who is to reign in our hearts.

Again, I invite all of our parishioners when you are able to participate in our church at the Divine Liturgies. Watching it online is not enough. There is a certain strength when we are together singing and praying together. The Church is also a community. This is only built by personal presence in both prayer and in helping each other in our various projects, be it the perogy bee, outreach, church cleaning and upkeep, special projects like the Yarmarok, helping in our catechism program, helping and participating in Coffee Klatch, etc. There is much more that can be done, but it has to be initiated by you. Do not be afraid to take on projects. (Of course, with the approval of the pastor). ST. Joseph's now has new life with the presence of our new-comers. Let us allwork together to make St. Joe's a vibrant, faith-filled, praying and loving church family.

One of the most rewarding experiences from the recent trip to Ukraine was to visit the Unbroken Centre. It is one of the largest hospitals in Lviv, seeking to heal the whole person: physical, mental and spiritual. It was particularly established with the help of Canada and others to help all those wounded and traumatized by the war. Mary Jane Kalenchuk and I received a tour from the main psychologist in charge of this centre. Wesaw and met many wounded soldiers and others wounded by the war. We saw the wonderful and I would say ground-breaking work that is being done to help heal those wounded, giving them dignity and hope. It is definitely a cause worthy of support. More information can be found on their web-site. Just type Unbroken Centre in Lviv. Thousands are being treated there. I will share more later.

Two Russian Invasions a Century Apart: Echoes of 1917–21 in the Current Russo-Ukrainian War by Serhy Yekelchyk

From the outset of Russian aggression against Ukraine in 2014, striking parallels emerged with the Bolshevik invasions of Ukraine during the Revolution of 1917–21: the denial of Russian military involvement in what was portrayed as a Ukrainian "civil war," assertions that the industrial southeast was inherently "Russian," and the ruthless exploitation of

Ukraine's resources. Although Vladimir Putin prefers to identify with General Denikin's White Army and to attribute the "creation" of Ukraine to Lenin, a closer examination of early Bolshevik policies in Ukraine reveals deeply colonial attitudes. It was only the resistance of the Ukrainian peasantry and the existence of the Ukrainian National Republic that compelled Lenin to make concessions to Ukrainians – concessions that were never meant to be permanent. In this light, Putin and the Bolshevik leaders appear cut from the same cloth, their policies alike paving the way toward genocide.

Born and educated in Ukraine, **Serhy Yekelchyk** received a Ph.D. from the University of Alberta. He is the author of eight books on modern Ukrainian history and Russo-Ukrainian relations including the award-winning *Stalin's Citizens: Everyday Politics in the Wake of Total War* (Oxford University Press, 2014). A professor of History and Slavic Studies at the University of Victoria, Yekelchyk is current president of the Canadian Association for Ukrainian Studies
