#### Dear Parishioners:

As we begin Pylikivka, the pre-Christmas fast, let us try to do something special. This is a time in which we can give up something that we enjoy with the intention of preparing our heart for Jesus. The intention is very important because it is

always at this time a time of preparation to come to know our Lord deeper. Also we can do something for others – help them or be generous to them, especially the poor and the needy. We can bring food items (dry goods or cans) for our Outreach bin at the back of the church. We can volunteer with various charity organizations to deliver hampers etc.

Next weekend we commemorate the Holodomor, the forced famine by Stalin in Ukraine in 1932-33 when close to 10 million people starved to death. On Saturday, November 22nd there will be a special service, as we always do, before City Hall at 1:30 pm. It is an ecumenical service between the Orthodox and the Catholics. The consequences of the Holodomor can be seen in today war of aggression. The same principles apply ,- a desire to wipe Ukrainians from the map. Let us remember all those who have become victims of Russian (former Soviet) aggression.

I thank all those who have come and will be coming to help prepare for our Yarmarok happening on the last Saturday of this month, November 29. This year's Yarmarok will help to raise funds for medical supplies for our wounded soldiers in Ukraine. While in Ukraine I had the opportunity to meet some of them personally. Despite their wounded bodies (legs and arms missing) their spirit is resilient and they continue to do whatever they can to support the war effort in Ukraine. There are thousands who need our help and we can do whatever we can to help them. Thank you in advance.

Let us prepare ourselves for the celebration of the Birth of our Saviour!
