Pastor's
Desk*



Dear Parishioners,

On June 27th , we will celebrate the Feast of the New Martyrs of Ukraine. This group of men and women were raised to the glory of the altars 25 years ago, on June 27th ,2001, by late Pope St. John Paul II during his pilgrimage journey to Ukraine.

They were chosen by the Church because of their Christian witness, because they remained faithful to Christ, to His call in their lives, and continued to be Christ-like to others even as they were arrested, interrogated, tortured, and some even brutally killed. Among them were four men from the Redemptorist Congregation:

Bl. Bp. Nicholas Charnetsky, C.Ss.R. was a Redemptorist missionary (and later a bishop) who served in Volyn. There he worked for the Unity of the Church, having brought many parishes into the full communion with the Catholic Church. Having endured years of imprisonment, he continued to quietly serve persecuted Catholics upon His release from the prison. His resting place became a place of graces and thousands of people had come to pray for his intercession.

Bl. Ivan Ziatyk, C.Ss.R. during his years as a Redemptorist preached missions, retreats and was also involved with forming future Redemptorists. During persecution of the Church, he was appointed as Vicar General of our Church, representing imprisoned Metropolitan Josyf Slipyi. Finally he was imprisoned, tortured and sent to Irkutsk in Russia, where he was killed for his Christian faith. **Bl. Zenon Kovalyk, C.Ss.R.** was a young and energetic Redemptorist missionary preacher who preached hundreds of missions all over Halychyna and Volyn. He was not afraid to speak the truth from the pulpit as communists were trying to brainwash the people with their ideology. He was arrested, tortured and finally crucified on prison's wall.

Bl. Bp. Vasyl Velychkovsky, C.Ss.R. whose relics are enshrined in our Church. Vasyl was a Redemptorist missionary who worked in Halychyna and Volyn, preached many missions. He was arrested three times, endured many sufferings and tortures and years of imprisonment in death camps. He was ordained to the episcopacy by Metropolitan Josyf to lead the persecuted Church. When his health was ruined and his days numbered, he was released and expelled from then Soviet Union. He came to Canada and here, in Winnipeg, fell asleep in the Lord. His resting place is a place of many extraordinary graces for people from around the globe: Canada, USA, Ukraine, Brazil, Philippines, etc. May these holy men and women be for us an example how to be Christ-like to those around us, no matter how difficult situation we might find ourselves in. May these intercede for all of us and for peace in our wounded world.

I would like to thank the Knights of Columbus for their generous donation of \$4700 from the Lenten Fish Fry towards the needs of our parish. May God reward them for their generosity.

As you might've have noticed, the work on the Church's domes had started and will continue for the next 4-6 weeks (weather permitting). Also a stained glass window from the Nativity scene above the choir loft was finally sent for repairs having suffered from vandalism some years ago. Have a blessed weeks to come and Happy Canada Day on July 1 st . Let's hope and pray for a nice and warm summery weather.
