From the
Pastor's
Desk



Dear Parishioners,

Firstly, I would like to thank all of you for your prayers during my vacation. Moreover, I would like to thank all of you for your prayers for my mother's health. She is continuing her battle with cancer, but thankfully is at home and carries on with the work around the house.

Thank you to Fr. Ivan Dzhur, CSsR, who very capably looked after the parish during my absence, allowing me to not worry during vacation.

Sadly, one of our parishioners has passed away. Please keep +Patricia Lewak in your prayers. Her funeral will be held on Monday, July 20, 2026 at 2:00 pm here at the church.

For those of you who are available, please consider joining the Rosary for Ukraine, held on Wednesdays at 1:30 pm, along with devotions to Blessed Vasyl Velychkovsky at 7:00 pm.

On August 1st of each year, this is a special day for the Redemptorists around the world, and the parishes that we serve. "It is the Feast Day of St. Alphonsus Liguori, Bishop, doctor of the Church, and Founder of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. Alphonsus Liguori was born in Naples, Italy, on September 27, 1696, and spent his entire life in the kingdom of Naples. He was the firstborn of an aristocratic family, and completed his literary and scientific studies at home. He achieved his doctorate in civil and Church law at the age of sixteen. Alphonsus was ordained a priest on December 21, 1726 and served the poor sectors of Naples, giving himself especially to the catechesis and moral formation of the most simple people. As a member of Apostolic Missions, he also dedicated himself to the preaching of missions in the surrounding areas of the Kingdom of Naples. The Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer was born at Scala on November 9, 1732. Preaching and prayer formed the heart of the missionary activity of Alphonsus. Where he could not reach people with the spoken word, he sought to do so with his writings. His 111 works have gone through many editions. *Copiosa apud eum redemption (With the Lord, there is plentiful redemption)* Those words from Psalm 130 are the motto of the Redemptorists. St. Alphonsus Liguori chose those words to guide the Congregation he founded because they expressed his own profound experience of God. God loves us lavishly and extravagantly. God's love is manifested most amazingly in the Incarnation of Jesus Christ, who gave himself completely for God and humanity-a self-gift that reached its highest point in his death on the cross. Reflecting on the Incarnation as well as the passion and death of Jesus, St. Alphonsus came to appreciate more deeply the meaning of our redemption in Jesus. He founded the Redemptorists to spread that good news and proclaim our redemption in Jesus to the most abandoned, especially the poor. He died on August 1, 1787, at the age of ninety-one, and was canonized on May 26, 1839. He was proclaimed a doctor of the Church on April 26, 1950, and was declared a patron of confessors and moral theologians." *The tomb of St. Alphonsus is at the basilica in Pagani, Italy.* We are privileged to belong to this community and along with all of you to be sons and daughters of St. Alphonsus Liguori. 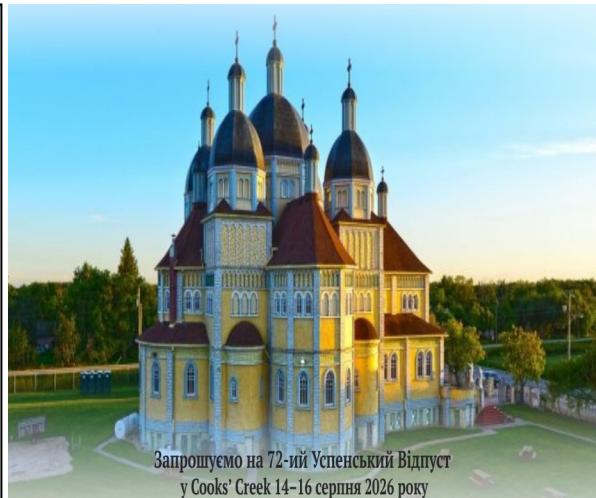

**Pope Leo XIV Appoints Most Rev. Michael Kwiatkowski
as New Metropolitan Archbishop of Winnipeg**

WINNIPEG — The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops in Canada are pleased to share the announcement made by the Vatican Press Service on Thursday, 9 July 2026, that His Holiness Pope Leo XIV has accepted the resignation of the Most Rev. Lawrence Huculak, O.S.B.M., Metropolitan Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg, upon his reaching the age of 75. Concurrently, His Holiness appointed the Most Rev. Michael Kwiatkowski, heretofore the Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of New Westminster, as the new Metropolitan Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg. The date of his installation will be announced as soon as it is determined.
