Dear Parishioners,

This last week, it was Ukraine's 35th Anniversary of Independence. A celebration took place at the Access Centre in West St. Paul. It was lovely to see many of our parishioners participating in the celebration, including taking an active roll in volunteering with the activities. I was pleasantly surprised to see our parishioner Gord Lasko playing like a "virtuoso" on the Tsybaly (hammered dulcimer). His performance was amazing to listen to.

As you know, Ukraine is still fighting for its Independence in this unjust war, and that's why we pray the rosary **at 1:30 pm every Wednesday**, for the end of the war and lasting peace in Ukraine. Please come and join us.

On **September 13th**, following the **10:00 am Divine Liturgy**, our Catechism Team will be hosting a **barbeque just for families with children 16 years of age and younger** to introduce a new youth programming for our parish. Please come and learn more about our new program.

On **September 20th**, we will be celebrating our **parish Praznyk**. **Divine Liturgy is at 10:00 am** followed by a catered sit down lunch. **You must purchase tickets to attend the lunch**. Please see more information in the bulletin.

Beginning on October 18th, we will return to TWO Divine Liturgies on Sundays ~ **9:00 am and 11:00 am**. Looking forward to seeing everyone there.

And now, I would like to share a few words about this Sunday's Gospel reading. Jesus tells a parable in which it compares the Kingdom of Heaven to a wedding that a king gave for his son. He calls the invited to the feast, but they do not come: each has some other business. We are invited to His heavenly kingdom. We know how we should live, but often we do not respond to God's invitation as each of us finds their own excuse.

Jesus says that the invited are many but the elect are few. What does 'many' mean? We are all called, each of us in every moment of our lives to become a participant in this Kingdom, this royal feast, this divine life. The Lord says also that the chosen ones are few, because each person chooses for himself: to respond to God's invitation or not. We are mostly preoccupied with earthly existence, with bodily affairs. Therefore, we need God's grace to live a spiritual life as well. That is why we are here today in our church in the presence of God, because we have responded to this invitation of God and we are convinced that the Lord gives us all the help of His grace for our Christian life.

In closing, please come and celebrate the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary on **September 8 at 8:00 am or 7:00 pm**. Mary is His great gift to us, as she is the greatest example on how to pray and say "yes" to God's invitation. Moreover, she helps us to answer positively to Jesus' invitation to enter His heavenly kingdom.

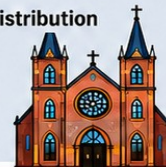
